ராமேசுவரம், ஜூலை.22 2021: பாம்பன் கடலில் நான்கு வழிச்சாலை பாலம் அமைக்க தேசிய நெடுஞ்சாலைத்துறை அதிகாரிகள் செவ்வாய்க்கிழமை ஆய்வு செய்தனர். ராமநாதபுரம் மாவட்டம், மண்டபம் ராமேசுவரம் தீவுப்பகுதியை இணைக்கும் வகையில் வாராவதி கடல் பகுதியில் 2.2 கிலோ மீட்டர் தொலைவுக்கு 1914 ஆண்டு கப்பல்கள் வந்து செல்லும் வகையில் ரயில் பாலம் அமைக்கப்பட்டது. இதை தொடர்ந்து, ரயில்பாலம் அருகே 1973 ஆம் ஆண்டு தேசிய நெடுஞ்சாலைத்துறை சார்பில் கப்பல்கள் இடையூறு இன்று வந்து செல்லும் வகையில் 100 மீட்டர் உயரத்தில் பேருந்து பாலம் அமைக்க கட்டுமான பணியை அப்போதைய பிரதமர் இந்திரா காந்தி தொடங்கி வைத்தார். இதன் பின் சுமார் 15 ஆண்டுகள் பாலப்பணிகள் நடைபெற்று 1988 ஆம் ஆண்டு பிரதமர்



ராஜிவ்காந்தியால் திறந்து வைக்கப்பட்டு தற்போது வரை பயன்படுத்தப்பட்டு வருகிறது. சாலைப்பாலம் திறந்து பின்னர் ராமேசுவரம் தீவு பெரும் வளர்ச்சி கண்டது. தற்போது ஆண்டுக்கு 1.50 கோடி சுற்றுலா பயணிகள் பக்தர்கள் வந்து செல்லும் இடமாக மாறிவிட்டது. மேலும் பேருந்து பாலத்தில் கரோனா காலகட்டத்திற்கு முன்பு நேரங்களில் சுற்றுலா பயணிகள் பெருந்து பாலத்தில் வாகனத்தை நிறுத்தி விட்டு கடலில் அழகை ரசிப்பதால் ஏற்படும் போக்குவரத்து நெரிசல் இதனால் பல விபத்துக்கள் ஏற்பட்டுள்ளது. இந்நிலையில், பழைய ரயில் காலத்திற்கு அருகே இரு வழி தடத்தில் ரயில் பாலம் கட்டுமான பணிகள் தொடங்கி நடைபெற்று வருகிறது. மேலும் நாடு முழுவதிலும் சாலைகளில் போக்குவரத்து நெரிசல் காரணமாக சாலைகள் தரம் உயர்த்தப்பட்டு 8 வழிச்சாலை, 6 வழிச்சாலை, நான்கு வழிச்சாலை

Whether future waves will affect children more or with increased severity are all speculations - Dr. Praveen Kumar

Chennai, July 22, 2021: Dr. Praveen Kumar, Director, Department of Pediatrics, Lady Hardinge Medical College, New Delhi talks about various issues including impact of COVID-19 on children, the need to protect them, and vaccinating pregnant women and lactating mothers.

How has the pandemic affected children's mental and physical health? What needs to be done to reduce its long-term impact?

Pandemic can have a severe effect on children's mental and physical health. They are confined at home for more than a year. Moreover, illnesses in the family, wage losses for parents have increased stress. Children may express psychological distress (sadness) by acting out in a different way each child behaves differently. Some may become silent while others may express anger and hyperactivity.

Caregivers need to be patient with children and understand their emotions. Look for signs of stress in young children, which could be excessive worry or sadness, unhealthy eating or sleeping habits, and difficulty with attention and concentration. Families also need to support children to

cope with stress and also allow their anxiety.

Do you think the future waves can affect children more severely? How does the country need to prepare for any future wave of COVID-19 with respect to providing quality care to pediatric patients?

As we all know, COVID-19 is a new virus that has potential to mutate. Whether the future waves will affect children more or with increased severity are speculations. People speculate that future waves may affect children more as most of the adults will be vaccinated in the next few months while we do not have any approved vaccine for children at this point in time.

Though we don't know how the virus is going to behave and affect children in the future, we need to protect our children from the contagion. Adults in the house should follow COVID-Appropriate Behavior, and limit their social engagements to reduce the chances of infection as they may carry and transmit the infection to others. Besides, all the adults should take vaccines, which will also protect the children to a great extent.

And now vaccine is

available for pregnant women and lactating mothers. This will give a certain degree of protection to the growing foetus and new-born against the deadly infection.

How has the second wave of COVID-19 affected children?

Second wave has affected children equally. COVID-19 is a new virus and it affects all age groups because we do not have natural immunity against this virus. As per the NCDC/IDSP dashboard, approximately 12% of infected COVID was contributed by patients less than 20 years of age.

Recent surveys have shown similar seropositivity in children and adults. However, due to a larger number of people affected during second wave number of infected children were also more as compared to the first wave. So far, the mortality rate in children is lower as compared to adults and is usually seen in children with comorbidities.

What were the challenges that you faced in treating pediatric patients, especially those who required hospitalisation?

Largely we were able to manage children well by increasing number of

dedicated beds for COVID infected children. However, during peak of second wave we faced some challenges as many of senior doctors, resident doctors, staff nurses became positive. We also faced challenges in accommodating all referrals during peak of second wave.

What is MIS-C? Please elaborate on the condition, the challenges that you face while treating an MIS-C case? If you think parents need to be aware of it? Its treatment

The multisystem inflammatory syndrome (MIS) is a new syndrome seen in children and adolescents (0-19 years of age). Most patients report it two to six weeks after the peak of COVID-19 infections in the affected population.

Three types of clinical course are described: Persistent fever with Raised Inflammatory parameters, Classical Kawasaki Disease like presentation and Shock, LV dysfunction with the inotropic requirement. For establishing the diagnosis of MIS - C, advanced investigations are required. All suspected cases should be referred and managed in a tertiary care hospital with HDU/ICU facility. If identified early, all these cases can be treated.

Vice President lauds 14 engineering colleges for offering courses in regional languages

Chennai, July 22, 2021: Lauding the move of 14 engineering colleges across eight States to offer courses in regional languages, the Vice President, Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu has urged more educational institutions, particularly those imparting technical and professional studies to follow suit.

He affirmed that providing courses in the regional languages will serve as a boon to the students. Expressing his fervent desire, Shri Naidu said, "It is my desire to see the day when all vocational and professional courses like engineering, medicine and law are taught in mother languages."

In a Facebook post titled 'Engineering courses in mother language—A step in the right direction', posted in 11 Indian languages today, the Vice President expressed his happiness over the decision of the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) to permit B. Tech programmes in 11 native languages—Hindi, Marathi, Tamil, Telugu, Kannada, Gujarati, Malayalam, Bengali, Assamese, Punjabi and Odia. He also welcomed the decision of 14 engineering colleges across eight states for offering regional languages in select branches from the new academic year. He said, "I strongly believe that it is a step in the right direction."

Referring to the benefits of learning in the mother

tongue, the Vice President said it enhances one's grasping and comprehension levels. "To understand a subject in another language, one has to first learn and master that language, which needs a lot of effort. However, this is not the case while learning in one's mother tongue," he added.

Highlighting our country's rich linguistic and cultural heritage, the Vice President said that India is home to hundreds of languages and thousands of dialects. He said, "Our linguistic diversity is one of the cornerstones of our rich cultural heritage." Emphasizing on the significance of mother language, Shri Naidu said, "Our mother language or our native language is very special to us, as we share an umbilical cord relationship with it."

Citing a UN report that one language in the world becomes extinct every two weeks, Shri Naidu expressed his concern that 196 Indian languages in India are endangered. He said, "There is a need for adopting a multipronged approach to protect our native languages and promote learning in the mother tongue." Shri Naidu called upon people to learn as many languages as they can. He said that proficiency in different languages would provide an edge in today's interconnected world. "With every language we learn, we



deepen our connection with another culture," he added.

Appreciating the steps taken by the government to protect languages, the Vice President pointed out that New Education Policy encourages imparting education, wherever possible in mother tongue/local language/regional language/home language at least till Class 5 and preferably till Class 8 and beyond. He said that many studies across the world have established that teaching in the mother tongue in the initial stages of education boosts a child's self-esteem and enhances his or her creativity.

Shri Naidu also appreciated the Scheme for Protection and Preservation

of Endangered Languages (SPEEL) under the Ministry of Education for documenting and archiving languages that have become endangered or are likely to be endangered in the near future.

The Vice President said that the government alone could not bring about the desired change. He said, "People's participation to protect our beautiful languages is critical to strengthen this thread of connectivity for our future generations." Noting the hesitancy amongst people to communicate in their mother tongue, Shri Naidu urged people to speak in their mother tongue not only at home but wherever possible. He said, "Languages thrive and survive only when used extensively."
