

Role of a public communicator is to bring government closer to the people – Vice President

Chennai, October 20 2021: The Vice President, Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu today emphasized the role of effective communication in good governance and called upon the public communicators to empower people through timely information on government's policies and initiatives in local languages.

Interacting with a group of Officer Trainees of the Indian Information Service (IIS) of the 2020

batch at his residence in Hyderabad today, the Vice President said that public communicators play an important role in bridging the gap between governments and citizens. "If you inform people about various schemes in simple and clear language, they understand their entitlements and government processes in a better way. This results in transparency," he told the probationers.

Shri Naidu further said

that 'information with confirmation' was the key to government communication and asked the Information Service officers to focus on combating misinformation and fake news. He also asked them to work on socially relevant themes such as gender inequality and removing vaccine hesitancy among some sections of people. Calling media as a powerful tool, he wanted this tool to be used responsibly to bring about the desired



transformation. "Connect, communicate and change," the Vice President said in his signature style.

The IIS Officer Trainees are in Hyderabad as part of their training attachment to the regional

office of the Press Information Bureau and other Media units of the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting. Congratulating the young officers on their selection in the civil services, the Vice President said that the Information Service has a big role to play in terms of empowering people with the right information.

Recalling his own journey from being a farmer's son to one of the highest offices of the

country, Shri Naidu advised the probationers to work with undivided dedication to achieve success. "Aim high, dream big, work hard and maintain discipline - this is my mantra to succeed in life," he told the young Civil Servants.

The Vice President also advised the Officer Trainees to keep fit by taking regular part in sports and physical activities. "In order to move towards a better future, the work done

today should be in consonance with both nature and culture," he said.

Union Minister Dr Jitendra Singh launches Air Quality Early Warning System to coincide with Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsava

Chennai, October 20 2021: Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) Science & Technology; Minister of State (Independent Charge) Earth Sciences; MoS PMO, Personnel, Public Grievances, Pensions, Atomic Energy and Space, Dr Jitendra Singh has launched Air Quality Early Warning System (AQEWS) on the occasion of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav week organised by the Ministry of Earth Sciences.

Dr Jitendra Singh said

that Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology (IITM), an autonomous Institute of Ministry of Earth Sciences has developed a new Decision Support System (DSS) and extended the ability of the existing air quality early warning system (AQEWS) to have decision-making capability for air quality management in Delhi - NCR region.

The need was stated by Commission for Air Quality Management in the National Capital Region and Adjoining Areas

(CAQM, which was recently formed by the Union Minister for MoEFCC with the approval of both the houses of parliament) during the meeting held in January 2021 and requested MoES institutions (IITM and IMD) for the same. Recently, the commission has reviewed the progress made by IITM and has in principle approved the current version of DSS for air quality management in the Delhi-NCR region. IITM, Pune has also developed a new website



for DSS and recently, the entire system has been made-operational.

DSS is a significant contribution to Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsava on behalf of MOES and IITM and

suggestions are invited on this issue.

Following is the link to the website <https://ews.tropmet.res.in/dss/> (At present the website is viewed best in Desktop

and soon it will be made compatible with mobiles On Android and iPADS (IOS).

The website is designed to deliver quantitative information about:

- a) the contribution of emissions from Delhi and the surrounding 19 districts to the air quality in Delhi,
- b) the contribution of emissions from 8 different sectors in Delhi their contribution,
- c) the contribution from biomass-burning activities

in the neighbouring states to the degradation of air quality in Delhi,

d) the possible quantitative effects of interventions at the on the forecast air-quality event in Delhi. All this information would assist in managing the air quality in a timely manner.

The website also has a feature whereby the users can create their own emission reduction scenarios (from 20 different districts including Delhi) so as to examine the

possible projected improvement in air quality in Delhi for the next five days. This information would explicitly highlight the most important emission sources responsible for the degradation of air quality in Delhi and suggest possible solutions to ameliorate the same and could be used by policymakers. With a plethora of quantitative data, the AQEWS integrated with DSS could become user friendly tool for air-quality management in and around Delhi.

Union Minister Dr Jitendra Singh says, North East to be developed as India's Bio-Economic Hub

Chennai, October 20 2021: Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) Science & Technology; Minister of State (Independent Charge) Earth Sciences; MoS PMO, Personnel, Public Grievances, Pensions, Atomic Energy and Space, Dr Jitendra Singh said that Northeast is to be developed as India's Bio-Economic Hub.

The Minister said, the Eastern Himalayan Region is one of the mega-biodiversity rich zones and is among the 34 biodiversity Hotspots of the world. He said, there is a need to put these invaluable genetic resources to use for the economic growth of the region in particular and to the nation in general, through biotechnological interventions. He was speaking after visit to the Institute of Bio-resources and Sustainable Development (IBSD), Imphal.

Dr Jitendra Singh said, due to consistent and renewed focus of Modi Government, India will be recognized as a Global Bio-manufacturing Hub by 2025 and will figure among the top 5 countries of the world. He said, India's Bio-Economy is on its way to achieve 150-billion-dollar target from the current 70 billion-dollar by 2025 and will contribute effectively to the Prime Minister's vision of a 5 trillion-dollar economy by 2024-25.

Dr Jitendra Singh said that on the directives of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, the Department of



Biotechnology has played a pivotal role to build capacity in the North Eastern region for carrying out biotechnology research to address issues specific to the region and implement programmes for the societal upliftment of the local communities as the North Eastern region is a genetic treasure house of plant, animal and microbial resources.

Dr Jitendra Singh said that IBSD should not only become a center of excellence in the region with state-of-the-art facilities but also generate technology packages toward employment generation for the welfare of the people. The Institute should be people centered and follow imaginative and innovative approaches to win the confidence of the people through its work, he added. The Minister added that this institute should emerge as a vibrant, active and committed center for research application and commercialization of technology, products and processes and should promote enterprises based on the rich bio-resources of the region to bring happiness to the entire

North Eastern region.

Dr Jitendra Singh informed that DBT-funded Phyto-pharmaceutical Lab Facility at IBSD is promoting the Phyto-pharmaceutical Mission of North Eastern Region. This Mission that aims to promote the documentation, scientific validation and evaluation of traditional healthcare practices is an important step and assumes special significance in the context of the vast plant resources and diverse traditional healthcare practices of the North-East. He said, the transformational approaches in developing products, processes and technologies with local bio-resources will help in development of traditional knowledge-based therapeutic agents leading to the socio-economic development of the region as well as benefits to traditional health care practitioners.

Giving examples of various successful interventions, Dr Jitendra Singh said that the DBT has supported a project on pilot scale demonstrations of strawberry cultivation with sustainable agro-

technological interventions using high-quality planting material in farmers' fields in Meghalaya jointly at Bio-Resources Development Centre, Shillong and Institute of Horticulture Technology, Mandira, Assam. He said, about 50 tissue-culture raised plantlets of elite varieties of strawberry are proposed to be distributed to the farmers in Manipur.

Similarly, the DBT has designed a programme to improve the production and productivity in Khasi Mandarin, an important fruit crop by producing quality planting material through shoot-tip grafting technology. The programme has a target of producing four lakhs certifiable disease-free quality plants of Khasi Mandarin and Sweet Orange during the three years duration of the project and build capacity of at least 1,000 farmers in the region. Fifty plants of grafted Khasi Mandarin have been generated at AAU-Citrus Research Station, Tinsukia, Assam and will be handed over to the farmers in Manipur state, the Minister added.

The DBT has established a Biotech-KISAN Hub at Horticultural Research Station, Assam Agricultural University (AAU), Kahikuchi, for large scale production of quality planting material of Malbhog banana, which is in high demand in the state of Assam. About 50 macro-propagated Malbhog bananas are proposed to be distributed to the farmers of Manipur.

Multi-disciplinary team from National Jal Jeevan Mission visits Rajasthan

Chennai, October 20, 2021: A multi-disciplinary 10-member team from National Jal Jeevan Mission (NJJM) is visiting Rajasthan from 18th to 21st October, 2021 in five districts of Baran, Dausa, Jodhpur, Bhilwara and Jaipur. NJJM team will daily visit 3-5 villages in each district. Various aspects of programme implementation and progress made under the mission by the State will be discussed to understand the ground situation and assess the State's preparedness to meet the saturation deadline for ensuring 100% tap water supply to all rural households. During the visit, the team will interact with district officials, local village community, members of Gram Panchayat and PaniSamiti. Thereafter the team will debrief and share their observations with the district officials as well as senior officers of the State Government.

Rajasthan plans for 100% tap water connection to all rural households by 2024. Out of 1.01 Crore rural households in the State, only 11.74 lakh (11.59%) rural households had tap water supply as on 15th August 2019, when Jal Jeevan Mission was announced by the Hon'ble Prime Minister.

Despite lockdown and disruptions due to Covid-19 pandemic, in last 2 years, 9.48 lakh households (9.36%) have been provided tap water connections. Today, 21.22 lakh rural homes (20.95%) in the State have tap water supply. Rajasthan faces



extreme water scarcity in many parts of the State as it is a desert-prone area which receives scanty rainfall. The need for providing safe drinking water therefore becomes very important and urgent in the State.

In 2020-21, Rs 2,522.03 Crore Central grant was allocated to Rajasthan but it could draw only Rs 630.51 Crore due to slow pace of implementation. To assist the State to provide tap water supply to every household by 2024, Union Minister, Jal Shakti, Shri Gajendra Singh Shekhawat has increased the Central allocation four-folds. Rs 10,180.50 Crore Central fund allocation for the implementation of Jal Jeevan Mission in the State during 2021-22. With enhanced Central allocation and matching State share, Rajasthan has no dearth of funds under Jal Jeevan Mission for water supply works. However, the State is yet to draw the first tranche of Central allocation due to slow physical and financial progress.

In addition to this, in

2021-22, Rs 1,712 Crore has been allocated to Rajasthan as 15th Finance Commission tied grant for water & sanitation to Rural Local Bodies/ PRIs. There is an assured funding of Rs 9,032 Crore for the next five years i.e. up to 2025-26.

Union Minister, Jal Shakti, Shri Gajendra Singh Shekhawat who himself is a Member of Parliament from Jodhpur has written to the Chief Minister of Rajasthan emphasizing that the work of providing tap water connection should start in all the villages to achieve the goal in a time-bound manner. Union Minister had urged the State to make all out efforts to receive and utilize the entire Central grant-in-aid available.

To ensure tap water reaches every learning centre which includes schools, anganwadicentre and ashramshalas, efforts are made by every State to make provision of tap water supply in these institutions for drinking, cooking mid-day meal, washing hands and use in toilets. As of now, 54,851 (63%) schools, 25,934 (48%) Anganwadicentre and 18,799

GP and CHCs (62%) in the State have been provided with tap water connection. The State has been requested to ensure piped water supply to remaining schools and AWCs at the earliest.

With focus on public health, nation-wide online Water Quality Management Information System (WQMIS) has been launched, which is in line of Covid-19 testing and reporting system, by using the reports generated from water quality testing through FTKs as well as laboratories. More than 2,000 water quality testing laboratories in the country have been opened to general public for testing their water samples at a nominal cost.

At the time of announcement of JJM on 15th August 2019, out of a total 18.93 Crore rural households, 3.23 Crore rural households (17%) of the country had tap water supply. Since then, over 5.11 Crore (26.60%) families living in rural areas have been provided with tap water connections. Now, more than 8.35 Crore (43.44%) rural households have assured potable tap water supply in their homes, improving their quality of life and enhancing 'ease of living'. Covid-19 pandemic and subsequent disruptions have affected the implementation of JJM on the ground but, National Jal Jeevan Mission is working closely with States/ UTs to sustain the momentum to provide tap water connections to remaining rural households in a time-bound manner.

Sarbananda Sonowal lays Foundation Stone for various capacity augmentation projects at Deendayal Port, Kandla, Gujarat

Chennai, October 20, 2021: Union Minister for Ports, Shipping & Waterways and AYUSH Shri Sarbananda Sonowal laid the Foundation Stone for various capacity augmentation projects at Deendayal Port (DPT) at Kandla today. These included:

- 2 Nos. Dome Shaped Godowns to be constructed within 12 months which will increase the covered storage capacity by 1.45 lakh metric tonnes at a cost of Rs.36 crore.
- Oil Jetty No.8 at Old Kandla at a cost of Rs.99 crore, which will be constructed in 18 months' time and increase the optimal capacity of Port by 3.50 MMTPA and reduce the waiting period turnaround time of vessels.
- Parking Plaza for Trucks/Vehicles with ancillary facilities like canteen, garage, rest shelter, etc. being developed for pre-gate verification of documents to ease congestion of vehicles at the gates corresponding with digital initiatives like EBS & RFID being installed at these gates at a cost of Rs.14.59 crores.
- Modernization of



existing Pipeline Network, at a cost of Rs.126.50 crore has also been taken up for operational efficiency and to improve handling capacity of edible oil and chemicals at the Port. The project will increase the optimal capacity from 8 MMTPA to 23.8 MMTPA.

The Minister inspected the progress of ongoing work Road-over-bridge at LC-236, Kandla being executed by M/s. IPRL. Incidentally, the foundation stone of this prestigious ROB project was laid by the Prime Minister. Shri Sonowal also inaugurated the "Aayush Van" at DPT's Rotary Forest for nurturing various ayurvedic plants. He inspected tree-plantation being done on 30

acres of land allotted by DPT in Green-belt area to improve greenery in urban area and density of tree cover in the Kutch Region.

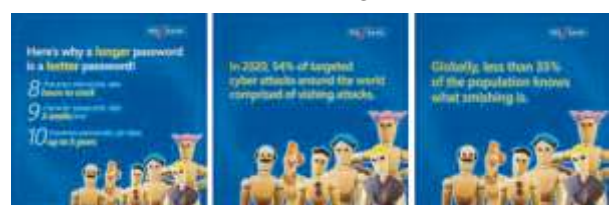

The paper honeycomb board provides adequate cushioning that can help in protecting the products from potentially damaging shock, vibration, and dents during transit. The paper used for packaging material is made of 70% recycled paper and is 100% recyclable making it an obvious environment friendly choice. This honeycomb packaging has replaced approximately 100 tons of thermocol that was used in packaging.

Godrej Interio is also taking a proactive initiative to replace multi-layered plastic for its mattress packaging. As a part of the company's sustainability initiative, options like biodegradable and recyclable packaging materials (Polyethylene as a "mono-material" and 60 microns thick) are being used.
