



Towards abatement of air pollution in the National Capital Region and adjoining areas on account of sporadic and unsustainable large scale paddy stubble burning incidents, continual efforts in this direction though have started to yield results, a lot is yet to be desired to comprehensively address this issue, t o w a r d s reduction of paddy environmentally sustainable disposal of paddy straw and abatement of air pollution in the region.

The Pioneers of Ayurveda


Multi-Generational Ayurvedic Practitioners continuing the legacy of their founder Vaidyaratna Pandit Divi Gopalacharulu

Chennai, Feb 20 2023: Ayurveda is often considered to be one of the oldest healing science in the world, with age-old wisdom and knowledge, passed through countless generations. Ayurveda enables, one to understand the balance of body, mind and consciousness according to the individual constitution.

The Government of India has established the AYUSH Ministry which is reviving the ancient health systems and propagating AYUSH. During the pandemic, KabasuraKudineer and Sasi Vilas which are immunity boosters with anti-inflammatory, antipyretic, and antibacterial properties were widely used to contain the spread of the Coronavirus.

One of the front runners of the Ayurvedic movement in Modern India was Vaidyaratna Pandit Divi Gopalacharulu, the founder of the renowned Ayurvedasramam Pvt He was instrumental in writing and publishing innumerable Ayurvedic books in Telugu like Madhava Nidanam, Arkaprakasha, PathyaPathya and many more. He played a pivotal role in keeping Ayurveda alive during the difficult periods of the Indian Independence

During the 1930's plague breakout, he saved thousands by incorporating two key medicines- Sasi Vilas and HemadriPanakam. For his great service rendered to society, he was bestowed the title of Vaidyaratna by British Viceroy, Lord Hardinge of Penshurst.
