# Chennai faces power cut at night for 2nd day as demand crosses 4000 MW

Chennai, May 17 2023: Chennai's power demand crossed the 4000 MW mark for the first time on Tuesday night with several localities witnessing power cuts for successive days.

On Tuesday night, the city's peak power demand an all-time high of 4,016 MW bettering the previous high of 3,991 MW recorded on May 15. The daily energy consumption also touched a record high of Puzhuthivakkam 90.34 million units on witnessed power cuts Tuesday.




