Pulianthope) officers and men of the above 15 Police Stations in North Zone worked hard to improve the infrastructure and also to speed up the work processes at Police Stations.

and Climate Sustainability, engaged with high school students monitoring water conditions in the Bay of Bengal followed by a shore walk at Elliot's Beach in the city on Thursday, July 27.

Administrator Regan, along with students, performed an experiment to measure temperature and salinity of sea water samples, an activity conducted as part of "Ocean Matters," an ongoing citizen science project organized by the U.S. Consulate General Chennai in partnership with

The Energy and Resources Institute (TERI) to build capacity of students to measure and monitor ocean health parameters.

EPA Administrator Regan said, "Young people have always been at the forefront of social movements and the environmental movement is no

Chennai, July 30 2023: "The goal of achieving green transition goes hand-in-hand with the larger goal of becoming Viksit Bharat by 2047 and the Hon'ble Prime Minister's mantra of Sabka Sath, Sabka Vikas. The discussions during this policy workshop have generated several important suggestions for green and sustainable growth which NITI will pursue through various fora", said Vice-Chairman, NITI Aayog, Shri Suman Bery.

NITI Aayog held a 2-day G20 policy workshop on 'A Green and Sustainable Growth Agenda for the Global Economy' at New Delhi. The 2-day workshop discussed prospects and challenges of green and sustainable growth globally. It was designated as a side event of G20 that covered various themes related to green growth, energy, climate etc.

On the sidelines of the G20 workshop, the

Chennai Nirubargal Sangam condemns arrest of writer Badri

Chennai, July 30 2023: In a joint statement by President R. Rangaraj and Secretary D. Sekar of The Chennai Nirubargal Sangam (Madras Reporters Guild) has condemned the arrest of journalist-writer Badri Seshadri with regard to his comments about the Chief Justice of India and the Manipur issue, and remanding him in judicial custody till August 11.

The action has been taken with regard to his views expressed to a Youtube channel, based on a complaint of a lawyer. There is absolutely no need to arrest writer Badri with regards to his political comments however



unpalatable they may be or even derogatory as far as the CJI is concerned. The Government has the option to file a case against the said writer and allow the law to take its own course, rather than take recourse to arrest, which comes in the way of freedom of speech and expression, and civil liberties.

It is upon the courts to take action, as they deem fit, in cases of

contempt of court, if necessary. The Guild views with concern the strategy of governments all over the country, including BJP and non-BJP governments, to straightway arrest persons for comments in the mainstream media and social media, rather than take the prosecution route in courts of law. The previous ADMK government had filed a

large number of defamation cases and also arrested presspersons. We request Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu, Thiru MK Stalin, not to follow this example.

The Guild urges Tamil Nadu Chief Minister Thiru M K Stalin to enable the immediate release of Thiru Badri Seshadri, and to give necessary instructions to the police department not to arrest persons for comments in the public domain on current affairs in the country. Arrest should be the last resort and only on the basis of final court judgements after the due legal process has been followed.

DD Returns - A well-staged, hilarious comedy Santhanam truly back with a laugh-heavy horror comedy



Chennai, July 30 2023: An event manager and his gang enter a haunted palace to retrieve the stolen money they had placed there. But things become a mess when they are forced to play a dangerous game organised by the ghosts inhabiting the palace. At a time when idiocracies are being passed off as horror comedies, there comes DD Returns, which stays true to the genre with tight writing and an engaging screenplay. The success of this film is that the team manages to evoke laughs at will with this crazy comic caper. In the very first scene, the film introduces us to a dangerous game called Win or Run, where the contestants are brutally killed upon failure to advance. However, the

family that is organising this deadly event gets killed by the villagers, leaving their ghosts to haunt a vintage French palace. We are then introduced to Sathish (Santhanam), an event manager, who is desperate to save his girlfriend (Surbhi), who is stuck in a predicament. He finds a lump sum of money and solves the issue, only to realise later that it was stolen from a dreaded businessman. The events that follow lead him to the haunted palace, where he and his team are forced to play a dangerous game by the ghosts. Will Sathish, along with his girlfriend, emerge victorious and escape the ghosts? What sets DD Returns apart from the other failed attempts in this genre is that the

sequences that are built to evoke fun are staged well with the right amount of craziness. The film cleverly steers away from 'cringe', which is typical in most horror comedies. While the first 20 minutes introduce a lot of characters and make us wonder if this is going to be just another chaotic attempt, director Prem Anand manages to turn the film into a fun-filled experience, with everyone ensuring that the hilarity lasts till the end. After a perfect setup in the first half, the second half goes into full throttle, with all the central characters getting into the game. The game, Win or Run, has four levels, and each round has a different task, creating the space to build perfect gags. The makers also bring in trending references, like Squid Game, YouTube

videos, and so on. Santhanam, who leads an ensemble cast, is in sublime form with his one-liners that land perfectly. There are subtle heroic moments where he scores without much effort. Surbhi, Redin Kingsley, Pradeep Rawat, Munishkanth, and Mottai Rajendran, along with other cast members, have played their parts to perfection. Masoom Shankar's role becomes a pivotal one as a film progresses, and she has done a decent job. Even the technical aspects of the film work for the genre, especially the scenes where we get to know the backstory of the ghosts and their intentions. Except for the first few minutes, DD Returns is undoubtedly a fun ride for movie lovers looking for a clean entertainer for the weekend.

Pizza 3: The Mummy A well-made horror mystery it truly is thrilling and a horror with emotion

Parallely, an influential man gets killed under mysterious circumstances, and Nalan's name gets dragged into this as well. The events that unfold further reveal the hand of a supernatural presence at his restaurant kitchen. Who this spirit is and how Nalan is connected to it form the rest of the crux. Mohan Govind begins the film in a very intense manner by setting up a perfect plot where a restaurant becomes the place of haunting. The hero, here, is a restaurant owner, and he's left with no clue

as to how the dish is appearing every day. All that is good, and the viewers are made to invest their interest in knowing who's behind this and what's exactly happening. The couple of jump scares in the first half work to an extent, mainly because of the technical aspects and staging. But then, trouble begins when we get to know more about the ghost and its backstory. The intention of the writer to deliver an emotional and heartbreaking backstory, it ends up being a dampening of the horror experience which was initially set up well. There are many twists like in previous installments, and the story goes on as a revenge tale.

Ashwin Kakumanu's portrayal of Nalan is decent and expresses his fear and confusion well. Pavithrah Marimuthu has done her part well, as she is one who tries to communicate with the ghost. Other characters showcased their abilities. Anupama Kumar and Abi Nakshatra, who came mostly in the second half, delivered their best as well. Director-actor Gaurav Narayanan plays Pavithrah's brother in the film and has done a good job. Coming to the technical aspects, which are definitely something to appreciate. Both cinematography and music, including the sound effects, complement each other like in previous installments, and the overall experience is enjoyable. Overall, Pizza 3 is a decent addition and a must watch.

COP28 UAE and UNFCCC urge G20 nations to show leadership on climate change mitigation and adaptation

Chennai, July 30 2023: Dr. Sultan Al-Jaber, COP28 President-Designate and Simon Stiell, Executive Secretary of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), have called upon G20 nations to take a greater leadership role in climate change mitigation and adaptation. With only 125 days to go, the leaders today issued a joint statement on the sidelines of the G20 ministerial meeting in Chennai, calling on G20 nations to "lead the way" on delivering a positive outcome on mitigation at the COP28 climate conference this year.



"The science demands a strong mitigation outcome at COP28 that drives a significant reduction in emissions and builds on the progress of previous COPs, and we call on the G20 to lead the way on the basis of both science and equity and lay the path to a strong and credible outcome that provides developing countries with the basis to undertake a just transition," the leaders said in the statement.

"Together, we must take necessary steps to accelerate the inevitable phase-down of all fossil fuels in a responsible manner, in order to have an energy system free of unabated fossil fuels by the middle of this century while enabling access for all and promoting sustainable development," they said in the statement, which

reiterated the importance of tripling global renewable energy capacity and doubling the rate of energy efficiency improvements across sectors by 2030.

While the discussions at the G20 Energy Ministerial considered energy transition and aligning current pathways with the Paris Goals, the outcome did not provide a sufficiently clear signal for transforming global energy systems, scaling up renewable and clean energy sources and responsibly phasing down fossil fuels.

"It is our hope that any progress achieved by the G20 drives decisively a strong outcome at COP28 under the Global Stocktake and capitalizes on the Just Transition Work Programme established at COP27 to ensure that this transition is fair, leaves no one behind and supports the broad development challenges faced by developing countries in launching this transition," the

statement added. The leaders also urged G20 nations to raise the importance of defining a Global Goal on Adaptation (GGA) and operationalizing the loss and damage fund and funding arrangements "to an equal level, to ensure that the human face of the climate change is at the center of all our decisions." Adaptation finance must be doubled urgently, the leaders said.

"The G20 must affirm its commitment to achieve the operationalization of the fund and funding arrangements. Those at the frontline of climate change need our support now, not in 5 years' time. This is the benchmark for ambition," they said in the statement. They also called on the G20 to show that it can deliver for the most climate vulnerable, including the least developed countries and small island developing states.

Delivering on the 2030 agenda will depend on making climate finance more available, affordable

and accessible to developing countries, the leaders state. "Climate finance arrangements will need to be transformed to deliver at the necessary scale, to work better as a system and to support private finance mobilization at unprecedented levels."

The leaders also called on G20 nations "to urgently prioritize your revised commitments, whether NDCs, NAPs or on climate finance, including contributions to the ambitious replenishment of the GCF to align with the Paris Goals."

"We must leave Chennai on the right path and with a clear signal that the political will to tackle the climate crisis and launch a new era of development is within our grasp, because it is only a short path to COP28. Every meeting counts, every outcome must bring us closer. The world needs its leaders to unite, act and deliver; and that must start with the G20," the statement concludes.
