Are your body fluids still being dried out by El Nino? Here are some solutions Pitchiah Kasinathan, Clinical Dietitian Fortis Malar Hospital

Chennai, Aug 07 2023: Due to the dry westerlies, certain districts of Tamil Nadu are sizzling due to unseasonal temperatures reaching 100 degrees and higher. Our bodies are still losing water because of the prolonged sweltering heat even though this season is meant to be cool. Due to considerable water loss through perspiration, the high temperature is making people feel uncomfortable and tired. To avoid heat-related problems, it is essential to stay hydrated throughout this period.

It's crucial to have enough fluids every day if you want to avoid becoming dehydrated. Dehydration occurs even if your body loses just 1 to 2 percent of its water. Dehydration can result in a variety of issues, including organ malfunction, fatigue, headaches, and muscle weakness. Therefore, it's crucial to stay properly hydrated. How can we do this through eating and drinking? Mr. Pitchiah Kasinathan, Clinical Dietitian, Fortis Malar Hospital has provided the following advice.

It's essential to drink lots of water on hot days to avoid dehydration. Additionally, including foods high in water content in one's diet can aid in lowering body heat and boosting natural cooling. The damaging effects of excessive heat on the human body can be lessened by making the proper dietary and lifestyle modifications. It's also a



good idea to consider millets like samai, thinai, varagu, and kambu.

1. Drink water with every meal and snack: Drinking 1 milliliter of liquid for every calorie consumed is a simple rule of thumb. Drink at least two to three liters of water each day but strive for three liters if you are more active.

2. Drink water before you feel thirsty: Your body is already dehydrated when you first start to feel thirsty. To determine if you are drinking enough, look at the color of your urine. It should be straw yellow when you urinate. Your fluid intake may need to be increased if you observe a darker yellow.

3. If you consume caffeinated beverages, balance it out with decaffeinated beverages: Alcohol and caffeine-containing drinks both cause diuresis. Instead of hydrating the body, diuretics cause the body to

excrete more water. Hence it should be compensated.

4. Dilute the juices: Fruit and vegetable juices might taste overly thick or sweet to certain individuals. Some individuals simply don't desire the extra calories. Try dilution with soda or water.

5. Eat the water: Most of your fluid requirements are satisfied by the water and other drinks you consume. You can also gain some fluids through the meals you eat. For instance, soups and broths like broccolis, bottle gourd, cucumber, tomatoes, or melons that are high in water content can help increase fluid consumption.

6. Bring a water bottle along: When participating in outdoor activities or doing errands, especially during the warmer months, this is a fantastic method to keep your hydration level up. Choose reusable bottles and make sure they don't

contain BPA.

7. Include citrus zest: You might enjoy your water more and want to drink more of it if you add a slice of lime or lemon and some honey to it.

8. Choose water over other beverages: Water is a healthier option than sugar-sweetened beverages including fruit juice, sports drinks, and regular or non-diet soft drinks. It can also help you save money and calories while improving your hydration.

9. Maintain a "water intake" journal: Seeing your past performance can inspire you to maintain your fluid needs. Try one of the many applications available for tracking calories, nutrients, and liquids.

Consider consuming fermented rice (Neeragam) once daily: When rice or millets are fermented for a whole night, their nutritional and energy contents significantly rise. It is regarded as the finest probiotic food because rice's antinutritional components are broken down by lactic acid bacteria, improving the micronutrient and mineral bioavailability. It is thought to be preferable to eat it for breakfast since the nutrition will be absorbed into our bodies and provide us an increase of energy to start the day. In the heat of the season, the body will be greatly cooled by the fermented rice water and a small amount of curd or buttermilk.

Bayer, GenZero and Shell collaborate to reduce methane emissions in rice cultivation

Chennai, Aug 07 2023: Bayer, a global enterprise with core competencies in the life science fields of agriculture and healthcare, in collaboration with GenZero, a Temasek-owned investment platform company dedicated to accelerating decarbonization globally, Shell Energy India Private Limited, a subsidiary of Shell Plc and investor in nature-based solutions, and other experts, is pleased to announce their efforts to develop a robust model to showcase the scalability of methane emissions reduction in rice cultivation. The proposed approach will include training, support, and guidance for smallholder farmers while utilizing Measurement, Reporting & Verification (MRV) mechanisms incorporating remote sensing technology. The project aims to set a benchmark for similar efforts in the rice decarbonization space.

Paddy rice cultivation is responsible for approximately 10% of global methane emissions[1], a potent greenhouse gas with a global warming potential over 27 times that of carbon dioxide. Rice farms occupy 15% of global farm area, equivalent to more than 150 million hectares worldwide[2]. It also consumes around one-third of the global fresh water[3]. To address the challenges of climate change and limit global temperature rise, a significant and scalable effort is required to promote methane emissions reductions in rice cultivation.

Bayer over the last two years has already done the necessary



groundwork and initiated a pilot Sustainable Rice Project across India. It started with an aim to generate carbon reductions by encouraging rice farmers to switch from the current practice of transplanting with continuously flooded fields to Alternate Wetting and Drying (AWD) that involves controlled and intermittent flooding and Direct Seeded Rice (DSR) that involves no transplanting operations and very limited flooding.

With this collaboration in place, the Program in its first year aims to significantly scale up its coverage to 25,000 hectares of rice cultivation during the Kharif 2023 and Rabi 2023-24 seasons. Any success achieved during this first year will pave the way for the implementation of an even larger-scale sustainable rice project. Beyond greenhouse gas reduction, the program is expected to generate other benefits such as water savings, soil health improvement, and enhanced community livelihoods for smallholder rice farmers.

Speaking about the program, Simon-Thorsten Wiebusch, Country Divisional Head, Crop Science Division of Bayer for India, Bangladesh & Sri Lanka said, "Bayer's commitment to rice

cultivation is two-fold. Through our focus on rice, we want to solve two of the biggest challenges impacting humanity, namely, food security and climate change. With this program, we aim to get more insights into how regenerative agricultural practices can contribute to mitigating climate change by way of methane emission reductions, water conservation, soil health improvements and drive sustainable development of smallholder farmers. Having the expertise and support of organizations like GenZero, Shell, International Rice Research Institute (IRRI) and others will go a long way in developing the ecosystem for faster adoption of such sustainable practices".

Frederick Teo, CEO of GenZero, said, "Rice is one of the leading sources of methane emissions, with India being the second largest producer of rice globally. Decarbonizing rice cultivation is therefore essential for fighting climate change and addressing food security challenges. With this program, we aim to transform the future of rice cultivation by driving the adoption of alternative wetting and drying as well as direct seeding techniques across smallholder farmers in India. The aim is to reduce the amount of water

required for farming across many water-stressed agricultural regions in India and reduce methane emissions arising from rice cultivation, supporting the transition of the agricultural industry towards a low-carbon future.

Flora Ji, Vice President Nature Based Solutions, Shell plc said, "Nature-based solutions, like this rice cultivation project, are an important additional tool in addressing climate change and contributing to sustainable development. We look forward to the outcome of this program to further strengthen capabilities and leverage novel technologies to deploy nature-based solutions at scale."

Speaking about the collaborative initiative with Bayer, Dr. Ajay Kohli, Deputy Director General for Research, IRRI said, "Public-private partnerships are an effective way to transform food systems, leveraging the strengths and resources of both sectors to achieve common goals. Such partnerships in agricultural science can improve the efficiency and effectiveness of research and development. By combining the strengths and resources of both sectors, and also sharing knowledge and capacity-building, thus enhancing the overall productivity and sustainability of the agricultural sector."
