

Action will be taken against Udhay and A Raja soon, says Annamalai

Veeramani questions RSS "newfound liking" for reservation

Chennai, Sep 11 2023: "Action will be taken against Udhayanidhi Stalin, A Raja and PK Sekarbabu like V Senthilbalaji," state BJP president K Annamalai said while addressing a protest by BJP here on Monday. Leading the dharna protest demanding the resignation of Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowment Department (HR&CE) minister P K Sekarbabu and dismissal of Youth Welfare and Sports Development Department minister Udhayanidhi Stalin in Valluvar Kottam, Annamalai said, "Udhayanidhi, a minister of Tamil Nadu spoke on the platform that they will eradicate Sanatana Dharma. After his speech, people are protesting all over India. Within four days of talking about Sanatana Dharma, the Chief Minister M K Stalin and his son Udhayanidhi changed their stand." "Sanatana Dharma came before religions. CM Stalin did not study anything and did not associate



with educated people. For India, Sanatana Dharma is the Dharma common to all and is not the one that subscribes Brahmin domination," he added. "BJP is a no-caste and non-religion party. After DMK came to power in Tamil Nadu, caste politics has intensified in the state. Annamalai also demanded a white paper over the state's claim on consecration of a thousand temples in these two years. "Now the HR &CE is advertising that they have done consecration to a thousand temples in these two and half years. While there are

lakhs of temples in Tamil Nadu, only 44,000 temples are under the control of HR & CE. The government should publish the details of the consecration ceremony to a thousand temples as a white paper," he added. "You (HR&CE) should leave our temples. If you leave the temples, we will take care of the breakfast and noon meal schemes," added Annamalai. "The next six months are very important days for us. I don't know whether Tamil Nadu will also have assembly elections along with the

upcoming parliamentary elections. But it is likely to come," he said. "If you (DMK) don't believe in God, keep it within your family. People like Udhayanidhi and A Raja who speak bad about Sanatana Dharma should be punished. Since DMK is in power, no case has been filed against them. BJP will come to power one day in Tamil Nadu. After BJP comes to power, action will be taken against Udhayanidhi and A Raja like V Senthil Balaji. Similarly, minister PK Sekarbabu should also be careful. Sekarbabu, who says that he does

not believe in caste, is the one who locked his daughter in a guest house just because she fell in love with someone from a different caste," added Annamalai. "With DMK opposing Sanatana Dharma, BJP will keep growing in Tamil Nadu and DMK has opened the door for us in Tamil Nadu," Annamalai said. While responding to a question over the murder threat to the DMK scion by Ayodhya seer Paramhans Acharya, the saffron party leader condemned the seer and said that he must be a fake seer. "That is wrong. If he (Ayodhya seer Paramhans Acharya) sets a bounty on someone's head like that, it means that he is not following Sanatana Dharma. When he says that he follows Sanatana, and puts a price on someone's head, then he must be a fake seer. I strongly condemn this. Who is he to pay the price to a head in our state?," Annamalai added.



Chennai, Sep 11 2023: Dravidar Kazhagam president K Veeramani on Monday questioned RSS chief Mohan Bhagawat's "newfound liking" for reservation and said that the RSS was adopting a new strategy after realizing that it cannot secure votes by making poll promises it cannot fulfil. Criticizing the RSS chief's statement supporting reservation to undo the caste based injustice meted out to OBCs and SC/STs for 2,000 years, Veeramani said that the RSS has realized that it cannot secure votes by making promises it cannot fulfil. "RSS requires a

new strategy because it is realizing daily that Prime Minister Narendra Modi would not help us secure votes. Social justice wave, Mandal wave has started sweeping across the country. The days of the saffron party in power are numbered. Perhaps,

Mohan Bhagawat, who shapes the policy of the ruling BJP, is attempting to sport the social justice mask at the eleventh hour," said Veeramani in a statement. "If the RSS or the saffron brigade want to prove me wrong, they must do two things. Will they implement reservation

in High Courts and Supreme Courts? Let them promulgate an ordinance and suitably amend the Constitution to implement the existing reservation policy in appointment of judges for the High Courts and the Supreme Court. Let the union government also constitute a social justice monitoring committee like the Tamil Nadu government to study the compliance with OBCs and SC/STs reservation norms in all its departments and ensure that the positions are filled accordingly," the Dravidar Kazhagam president added.

50 Manjappai vending machines to be installed in TN

Chennai, Sep 11 2023: Major markets and bus stands in the state will have cloth bag (manjappai) vending machines. The Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board (TNPCB) has decided to install 50 such machines. R Kannan, member-secretary of TNPCB said that around 100 bag vending machines have already been installed across the state. "However, such vending machines are installed by corporate firms under corporate social responsibility (CSR) initiative. The 50 machines will be



installed using TNPCB funds. The machines will be installed in bus stands and markets," he added. Presently, the bag vending machines are installed in Koyambedu Wholesale Market Complex (KWMC) also. As per TNPCB data, Chennai has 10 bag

vending machines. Women self help groups (SHG) have been given the opportunity to produce the bags. Public can get the cloth bags by inserting a Rs. 10 coin or note. The newly proposed vending machines will have a capacity of 500 cloth

bags each. The cloth bag vending machines are a part of Meendum Manjappai campaign which was launched by chief minister MK Stalin to put forth an alternative to one-time use of plastic bags. Under the campaign, more than 12.69 lakh raids have been conducted across the state against single-use plastic items and seized 2,146 tonnes of plastic items. In Chennai, more than 8.77 lakh raids were conducted and 448 tonnes of plastic items have been seized.

'Corruption not in his blood': Nara Lokesh slams Andhra govt

Chennai, Sep 11 2023: Telugu Desam Party (TDP)'s General Secretary and son of former Andhra chief minister N Chandrababu Naidu, Nara Lokesh on Monday said that "corruption is not in his father's blood and the state government's intention is to malign his image." "Corruption is not in Chandrababu's blood. He is a well-known personality in the country. Jagan (Andhra Pradesh CM) put former CM Chandrababu in jail intentionally, on false charges. All other political leaders called me up and extended their support to me," Nara Lokesh said while speaking to the media at Rajamundry. He was responding to the recent arrest of his father, N Chandrababu Naidu, and said, "Jagan, can you tell me the actual cases against you? Y. S. Avinash Reddy (Kadapa MP) had saved you from the police in the Vivekanand murder case." Former Andhra Pradesh chief minister and TDP president, N Chandrababu Naidu, was arrested by the Criminal Investigation Department (CID) on Saturday in connection to an alleged corruption case. His son Nara Lokesh further alleged that

his father has been targeted by this government ever since this government has come to power. "They (state government) have filed false cases in the past, this is one such case. This government's only intention is to malign his image. If you look at the facts of the case, the skill development project is not a new project. This project has been going on in various other states. It's nothing new that the state of Andhra Pradesh has done. We are not going to keep quiet. Our fight against this government will continue," the TDP general secretary said. Earlier in the day, a group of TDP workers staged a demonstration in Chittoor to protest against the arrest of their party chief Chandrababu Naidu. Some of the TDP workers allegedly pelted stones on a bus during the protest as the Road Transport Corporation (RTC) passenger vehicle came out of the depot. Protestors also set tires ablaze on the road. Expressing solidarity with TDP leader Nara Chandrababu, who was arrested and sent to



custody in the alleged skill development case, the TDP has called for a bandh across the state. The AP police have enforced Section 144 across the state. Even as the police moved to detain TDP MLC Srikanth he staged a sit-in on the road and raised slogans against the Jagan Mohan Reddy government in the state. Protests were also held in Tirupati and West Godavari districts against the arrest and judicial custody of Chandrababu Naidu. The case pertains to the establishment of clusters of Centers of Excellence (CoEs) in the state of Andhra Pradesh, with a total estimated project value of Rs 3300 crore, as per the officials.

G20 traffic restrictions lifted: Jams on several Gurugram roads



Chennai, Sep 11 2023: Traffic snarls and jams were witnessed on several Gurugram roads, including the Delhi-Gurugram Expressway, on Monday as heavy vehicles entered the city following lifting of restrictions imposed in view of the G20 Summit in Delhi.

The G20 Summit was held on Saturday and Sunday, but restrictions in Delhi and adjoining Gurugram came into effect from Friday. Commuters, particularly office-goers, faced a tough time reaching their destinations with heavy traffic congestion on the Delhi-Gurugram Expressway, the Jaipur

Highway, and the Faridabad-Gurugram Road as well as at Rajiv Chowk and the Kherki Daula Plaza. People stuck in jams in the morning took to social media to lodge complaints. Taking cognisance, the traffic police took efforts to provide respite to commuters, officials said. Rishi Kumar said that on Monday morning, there was a jam of more than a kilometer at Rajiv Chowk and it took more than 20 minutes to cross the Signature Tower. Assistant Commissioner of Police-Traffic (Highway) Priyanshu Dewan said that "after three days of restrictions, heavy vehicles also headed to Delhi today". "Because of this, there was traffic congestion but our personnel managed things and there was no traffic jam anywhere for a long time after that," the official said. Commuters going towards Delhi faced traffic jams near Signature Tower, Rajiv Chowk and IFFCO Chowk. Due to traffic jams on the main carriageway of the expressway, commuters coming from Badshahpur to Rajiv Chowk on the Sohna Elevated Road also faced problems. Besides this, there were also traffic jams near the Kherki Daula Toll Plaza, Golf Course Road and Sector-89.

ISRO conducts training programme for 35 Bhutan officials in Thimphu

Chennai, Sep 11 2023: The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) major centres Indian Institute of Remote Sensing (IIRS), Space Applications Centre (SAC), and National Remote Sensing Centre (NRSC) are conducting training in Thimphu, Bhutan for about 35 officials. "Experts from IIRS, SAC, and NRSC are conducting training in Thimphu for about 35 officials," ISRO posted on X (Former Twitter). Taking to X India in Bhutan posted, "The Indian Space Research Organisation in collaboration with GovTech inaugurated a 5-day training for officials of the Royal Government of Bhutan on applications of remote sensing technology for good governance."



manoeuvre (EBN#3) is performed successfully from ISTRAC, Bengaluru. ISRO's ground stations at Mauritius, Bengaluru, SDSC-SHAR and Port Blair tracked the satellite during this operation.

The new orbit attained is 296 km x 71767 km," ISRO said in a post on 'X'. Earlier on September 5, Aditya L1 successfully performed the second earth-bound manoeuvre, attaining an orbit of 282 km x 40225 km. After the successful landing of Chandrayaan-3 near the South pole of the moon, the ISRO launched the country's maiden solar mission -- Aditya-L1 from the Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota on September 2. It carried seven different payloads to have a detailed study of the Sun, four of which will observe the light from the Sun and the other three will measure in-situ parameters of the plasma and magnetic fields. Aditya-L1 will be placed in a halo orbit around Lagrangian Point 1 (or L1), which is 1.5 million km away from the Earth in the direction of the sun. It is expected to cover the distance in four months' time. Aditya-L1 will stay approximately 1.5 million km away from Earth, directed towards the Sun, which is about 1 per cent of the Earth-Sun distance. The Sun is a giant sphere of gas and Aditya-L1 would study the outer atmosphere of the Sun.

India sets sights on manned deep ocean mission 'Samudrayaan', reveals Kiren Rijiju

Chennai, Sep 11 2023: After a successful touch down on the lunar surface, India is planning to send three humans in 6-km ocean depth in its first manned deep ocean mission 'Samudrayaan', Union Minister Kiren Rijiju said on Monday.

National Institute of Ocean Technology in Chennai. Once commissioned, three humans will be able to go in ocean depth to study the deep sea resources and biodiversity assessment. "Next is Samudrayaan.
