

Prime Minister Lays Foundation Stone of BPCL's Krishnapatnam - Hyderabad Multi-Product Petroleum Pipeline

Chennai, Oct 02 2023: Prime Minister Narendra Modi, today laid the foundation stone of the Krishnapatnam to Hyderabad multi-product pipeline, a significant infrastructure project undertaken by Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited (BPCL). This groundbreaking ceremony took place at Mubarakpur in Telangana.

The project valued at Rs 1,932 Crore is slated for completion in the next two years by October 2025. The project will contribute significantly to generate employment opportunities, both direct and indirect, totaling over 13 lakh man-days. Post-commissioning, the Pipeline and POL Terminal at Malkapur will employ approximately 650 individuals.



Furthermore, it is poised to enhance socio-economic development in the districts through which the pipeline passes. As part of this project, the tankage

capacity at the existing Terminal in Krishnapatnam will undergo significant expansion, increasing from 100,000 KiloLiters (KL) to 164,000 KL.

The pipeline spans a length of 425 kilometers and is designed with a capacity of 2.6 Million Metric Tonnes Per Annum (MMTPA). It will establish a vital link between BPCL's POL Terminal at Krishnapatnam and a high-capacity Petroleum Storage Terminal in Malkapur, located near Hyderabad. The pipeline incorporates advanced safety measures, including Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) and Pipeline Intrusion Detection System (PIDS) for real-time monitoring, control, and data acquisition. It will significantly reduce the carbon footprint by replacing the need for 200 tank wagons and tank lorries, thus contributing to a greener and more sustainable future.

This monumental project underscores the Government of India's commitment to fostering infrastructural development, economic growth, and environmental sustainability.

Indian Coast Guard Pollution-Control Vessel Samudra Prahari visits Tanjung Priok Port, Indonesia

Chennai, Oct 23, 2023: In a significant demonstration of India's commitment to addressing regional marine pollution threats, the Indian Coast Guard Ship Samudra Prahari, a specialized Pollution-Control Vessel, arrived at the port of Tanjung Priok, Jakarta, Indonesia, on 01 Oct 23. This visit, a part of India's ASEAN initiatives for Marine Pollution Response, underscores India's expertise and collaborative efforts in tackling regional maritime challenges, particularly those related to marine pollution threats.

Sep to 14 Oct 2023, the specialized Pollution Control Vessel earlier made port call in Bangkok, Thailand from 16 Sep to 20 Sep 23. Equipped with a Chetak Helicopter in Pollution Response configuration, the vessel highlights India's commitment to enhancing pollution response capabilities in the region. As a part of an overseas exchange program, the ship has aboard 13 National Cadet Corps (NCC) cadets, who will participate actively in the "Puneet Sagar Abhiyan" thereby giving the Abhiyan an international reach. This program focuses on beach clean-ups and



similar activities, fostering collaboration with partner nations. The ship received a warm welcome from BAKAMAL (Indonesia Maritime Security Agency) band playing fanfare and other welcoming military tunes as a gesture to their Indian friends. During the four-day stay of the ship at Jakarta, ICG ship will engage with BAKAMAL in professional exchanges, cross-deck visits, table-top exercises, Pollution Response demonstrations, Joint Yoga sessions, joint exercises, as well as

official and social engagements, including visits to capacity-building facilities. The visit is an outcome of India's ASEAN initiatives as announced by Raksha Mantri Shri Rajnath Singh in the ASEAN Defence Minister Meeting Plus held last year in 2022 in Cambodia. The initiative aligns seamlessly with India's visionary approach, as outlined by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, encapsulated in "SAGAR - Security and Growth for All in the Region".

More than 30 lakh Audit Reports filed on Income Tax Department's e-filing portal till 30th September, 2023

messages on Income Tax portal to create awareness among the taxpayers to file the Tax Audit Reports and other audit forms within the due date.
