## Indian Army and Air Force Contingent Departs for India-Kazakhstan Joint Military Exercise KAZIND-2023



Chennai, Oct 29 2023: Indian Army and Indian Air Force contingent comprising 120 personnel departed for Kazakhstan today to take part in the 7th edition of Joint Military 'Exercise KAZIND-2023'. The Exercise will be conducted at Otar, Kazakhstan from 30th October to 11th November 2023.

Indian Army contingent comprises 90 personnel led by a Battalion from the DOGRA Regiment. The Kazakhstan contingent is mainly represented by personnel from Regional Command South of Kazakh Ground Forces. 30 personnel of Air Force

from both sides will also participate in the current edition of the Exercise alongside the Army contingents.

The Joint Exercise between India and Kazakhstan was instituted as 'Exercise PRABALDOSTYK' in the year 2016. After the second edition, the Exercise was upgraded to a company-level exercise and renamed as 'Exercise KAZIND'. The Exercise has been further upgraded as a Bi-service Exercise this year by including the Air Force component.

In this edition of the Exercise, both sides will practice conduct of Counter Terrorism operations in a sub-

conventional environment under United Nations mandate. The contingents will jointly rehearse various tactical drills to include Raid, Search and Destroy Operations, Small Team Insertion and Extraction Operations etc. The scope of the Exercise also includes conduct of Counter Unmanned Aerial System Operations.

'Exercise KAZIND-2023' will provide an opportunity for both sides to gain an insight into the tactics, battle drills and procedures of each other, which is a prerequisite while operating under the ambit of the United Nations. The joint training will develop the necessary skills, resilience and coordination to conduct joint military operations in Semi-Urban and Urban environments. Both sides will get a chance to practice drills on a wide spectrum of combat skills and mutually learn from each other. The Exercise will provide an opportunity for the contingents to exchange views and share the best practices. 'Exercise KAZIND-2023' will further strengthen the bond between the two armies.

Chennai, Oct 29 2023: The National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA) Ministry for Environment, Forest & Climate Change in collaboration with the Sankala Foundation is organising an art exhibition titled, "Silent Conversation: From Margins to the Centre", from 3rd November 2023 to 5th November 2023 at India Habitat Centre, New Delhi. The Hon'ble President of India, Smt Droupadi Murmu will be the chief guest of the inauguration ceremony which will be held on the 3rd November 2023 from 4:00 pm onwards. The Union Minister for Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Shri Bhubender Yadav, Union Minister for Tribal Affairs, Shri Arjun Munda and Minister of State, Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Shri Ashwini Kumar Choubey, will

also be present.

NTCA along with Sankala Foundation through this art exhibition is paying a tribute to the successful completion of 50 years of Project Tiger. Project Tiger is a wildlife conservation initiative in India that was launched in 1973 with the primary objective of protecting and preserving the Bengal Tiger, India's national animal and restoring its habitat so as to reverse the animal's alarming decline in previous decades. The project focuses on the selection and preservation of areas which are specially managed to conserve the tiger population and their associated ecosystems. Over the years, the number of Tiger Reserves has increased, and there are now 54 reserves across the country. An essential aspect of Project Tiger is involving local communities in

conservation efforts by providing livelihood opportunities and reducing human-wildlife conflicts.

The art exhibition will showcase the unique relationship between tribal communities and other forest dwellers residing around India's tiger reserves and their deep-rooted connection with the forest and wildlife, all conveyed through their artwork. The art work displayed will be in the form of paintings and reflect the age-old bonds of various tribal communities such as the Gond, Bhil, and many others. The paintings will be available for purchase, with the proceeds flowing directly into the bank accounts of the artists. Throughout the exhibition, not only will these diverse art forms be on display, but numerous tribal artists will also travel to Delhi and be present at the event, providing visitors and art

enthusiasts with an opportunity for direct interaction.

The National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA) was established in 2006. It has been at the forefront of tiger conservation work in India. Its work domain extends from on the ground protection initiatives to science based monitoring of tigers and their habitat using latest technological tools, independent assessment of tiger reserves, financial and technical support to tiger reserves, creating inviolate space for wildlife while ensuring community development to international co-operation are the few thrust areas of NTCA. The exhibition is being organised jointly by NTCA and the Sankala Foundation and will be the first in the series of such exhibitions in different Indian cities and across the globe.

## Apollo Hospitals Honours Stroke Survivors in Key Awareness Event

Chennai, Oct 29 2023: Apollo Hospitals, under the guidance of NeuroEndovascular Surgeon Dr. Srinivasan Paramasivam and Interventional Neurologist Dr. Karthikeyan today organized a special event to honour and celebrate the heroic journeys of stroke survivors. The event was attended by a host of luminaries namely Thiru. Justice K Kumaresh Babu, Hon'ble Judge of the Madras High Court, Mr. Vinay, GST Deputy Commissioner, Chennai, Bharathi Baskar, Tamil orator and public speaker, Senthil, actor and Rajmohan, motivational speaker. The day-long event was organized to raise awareness on stroke and emphasize the need for early intervention in quality stroke care. More than twenty stroke survivors were honoured with awards for fighting back and recovering from the condition. The Apollo Stroke Network was also launched at the event.

Stroke is a major public health challenge in India and across the world. It is one of the leading causes of acquired disability and mortality and places considerable socio-economic strain on patients and their families. There are two types of stroke, namely ischemic stroke caused due to reduction in blood supply to a part of



the brain and hemorrhagic stroke caused due to leakage of blood into a part of the brain. Nearly 80% of stroke cases are due to blood clots (ischemic) and 20% cases are due to bleeding (hemorrhagic).

Time is the most important factor in stroke management as 1,90,000 brain cells are lost every minute during a stroke attack. When a stroke patient reaches the hospital within 24 hours of onset, symptoms can be reversed with either clot-busting drugs or a pin-hole procedure called mechanical thrombectomy (where a stent retriever is used to remove a clot from the affected blood vessel.)

A stroke can attack anyone at any point in time. It is no longer a disease of the aged. Recent data suggests that strokes are being increasingly reported by one in four individuals above 25 years of age. However, the stroke risk increases with age and doubles for every decade a person is alive after the age of 55. Around 13 million suffer from stroke every year globally and nearly

10,000 people are affected by stroke in Chennai every year. Covid 19 has increased the incidence of stroke as the virus is known to aggravate clotting among individuals with co-morbidities such as diabetes and hypertension.

Suneetha Reddy, Managing Director, Apollo Hospitals Group, said, "Apollo Hospitals is delighted to launch the Apollo Stroke Network to respond to the needs of those with specific neurological conditions. We at Apollo appreciate that every minute counts and our stroke response model is designed on that principle. We also hope that the journeys of the survivors will enlighten and inspire stakeholders elsewhere to collaborate and fashion stroke care models that will greatly benefit their communities."

Dr. Srinivasan Paramasivam, Head of Neuroendovascular Surgery at Apollo Hospitals presented the structure of Apollo Stroke Network. Stroke being a time sensitive disease, protocol-based care with timely treatment is warranted.

Organized network among Apollo hospitals in Chennai to expedite the advanced care of stroke patients. Advanced care includes Neuroendovascular treatment of ischemic stroke like Mechanical Thrombectomy and Endovascular and Microsurgical treatment of Hemorrhagic stroke. Speaking about advances in stroke care Dr. Karthikeyan, Interventional Neurologist, Apollo Speciality Hospitals, said, "The emerging stroke treatments that we see today are time-dependent. We presently have 4.5 hours as the recognized time limit to initiate an intravenous thrombolysis in an indicated patient. Any sudden neurological development should be considered as a warning sign of stroke. Symptoms such as sudden vision loss, double vision, dizziness, vertigo, instability are key to understanding the condition. Awareness about stroke, the importance of time in stroke management and stroke prevention methods are abysmally low in our community. We are pleased to join hands with stroke survivors to help create more awareness around this critical concern."

## NHAI Awards Toll, Operate, Transfer (TOT) Bundles 11 and 12 for Rs. 6,584 Crore

Chennai, Oct 29 2023: NHAI has awarded two Toll, Operate and Transfer (TOT) bundles 11 and 12 of a combined length of 400 km for Rs. 6,584 crore. The two bundles (11 & 12) consist of Allahabad Bypass on NH19 in Uttar Pradesh and Lalitpur - Sagar - Lakhnadon section in the state of Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh respectively. The first round of bids for the two bundles was called-off and the bids were re-invited. In the 2nd round, NHAI has received bids for Rs. 553 crore higher than the bids received in the first round. The financial bids were opened on Friday, 27th October 2023 and with the approval of the

concerned authorities, Letter of Award has been issued to the successful bidder next day of opening of financial bids.

The TOT bundle 11 for the 84 km long Allahabad Bypass on NH19 in Uttar Pradesh has been awarded to Cube Highways and Infrastructure Ltd. for Rs. 2,156 crore. TOT bundle 12 for the 316 km long Lalitpur - Sagar - Lakhnadon section that passes through the states of Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh has been awarded to IRB infrastructure Trust for an amount of Rs. 4,428 crore.

Commenting on the successful award of the TOT Bundles, NHAI

Chairman Shri Santosh Kumar Yadav said "The Government has been very supportive and encouraging to achieve the national monetization targets. I am pleased that we have raised Rs. 6,584 crore from these two bundles, which will greatly contribute towards the development of a world class National Highway Network in the country."

The contract period of TOT is for 20 years in which Concessionaires would be required to maintain and operate the stretch. In lieu of this, Concessionaire will collect and retain user fee for these stretches in accordance with prescribed fee rates under NH Fee

Rules. TOT model has been developed to encourage private participation in Highway sector. NHAI from time to time, has awarded contracts for tolling, operation and maintenance of various National Highway stretches on Toll Operate Transfer (TOT) basis. The TOT Bundle-I consisting of nine projects, totaling 681 km of National Highways in States of Andhra Pradesh and Gujarat was awarded in 2018. Till now, NHAI has monetized 1614 km of projects for Rs. 26,366/- crore (excluding ToT bundle 11 & 12) through ToT and 636 km of projects for Rs. 10,200/- crore through InVIT.
