Chennai, Nov 21 2023: A spectacular championship of the JK Tyre presents Royal Enfield Continental GT Cup Season '23 concluded yesterday at the Kari Motor Speedway in Coimbatore. After a grueling racing season which started in August and spanned over three months, season 3 of India's uniquely inclusive motorcycle racing championship witnessed eight action-packed races over the course of three rounds. This season of the JK Tyre presents Royal Enfield Continental GT Cup was hotly contested in both the Amateur as well as the Professional categories, so much so that the outcome of both championships came down to the 8th and last race of the season.

The front runners for the Amateur category - Md. Samrul Zubair, Vignesh Goud and Kayan Patel all



finished within a 17 point gap with Zubair taking the Championship with 76 points and Goud and Patel equalling their points tally at 59 each, but Goud got the advantage due to his 3 race wins.

The Professional category was a roller coaster of a series, with Abhishek Vasudev, Jagadeesh Nagaraj and Ullas Nanda always fighting for the top 3 on the podium with the likes of Raj Kumar and

Soorya PM close at their heels. Finally, we ended up with Abhishek Vasudev at the top step of the championship with 54 points, followed by Nagaraj and Nanda with 45 and 39 points each.

The Continental GT Cup Season '23 proved to be the ultimate battleground for dedicated racers and the races were thrilling to watch with plenty of last minute action leading upto many nail

biting finishes.

In 2021, AkzoNobel India launched Project Indradhanush with one objective enabling women to drive micro-entrepreneurship and socio-economic development in rural India. The societal initiative that started from one village in Assam has now expanded to benefit women in 500 villages across the six states of Assam, West Bengal, Tamil Nadu, Haryana, Madhya Pradesh, and Karnataka.

Project Indradhanush has also created over 300 first time women paint entrepreneurs in 500 villages of India! Many of the Indradhanush paintpreneurs, who were earlier either homemakers or managing existing small shops including grocery,

stationary etc., are now transforming the paint industry in hinterlands while also adding a layer of financial resilience for their families.

Take the case of the 24-year-old Pallavi Bera from the Kulberia village in East Midnapore district of West Bengal. After undergoing the intensive Entrepreneurship Development Program (EDP) training, Pallabi started her own paint shop with support of AkzoNobel. Her paint shop has quickly gained popularity in her village and nearby areas and she's already changed her family's financial trajectory.

between Indradhanush women painters and small store owners.

In the Singimari village of Assam's Darrang district, Ajima Begum's journey from a homemaker to a successful entrepreneur is heartwarming. From taking care of her family for two decades, Ajima decided to become a paint entrepreneur at the age of 42. As her daughter Mariyam adds, Ajima now has a new sense of pride and confidence that she can achieve anything she sets her mind into. Also grasping the opportunity with both hands are the four entrepreneurs from a women's self-help group in Tamil Nadu. Previously blue-collar construction workers in their village, they're now building exciting new futures in the paint industry.

## Rising demand for Thematic and sectoral funds

Chennai, Nov 21 2023: Mutual Fund participation in India is increasing steadily if we go by the latest AMFI data. As much as 6% of the household savings is parked in the mutual funds by individuals if we go by the 'Indian Household Savings RBI Data 2023'.

The thematic funds and the sectoral funds as a category have been attracting regular inflows on a month on month basis according to the AMFI data for July, August and September month. In fact, according to the AMFI data for September the Thematic category saw inflows of Rs 3146.85 crore, highest in the equity category.

Accurate measurement is crucial for comprehending and tracking a child's growth." Moreover, it can aid in the early detection of growth deficiencies, enabling parents to take prompt action and address the underlying causes

2. Eat right: To support holistic growth, provide a balanced diet that includes cereals, pulses, milk, meat, fruits, and vegetables daily. This ensures your child receives the necessary protein,

vitamins, and minerals for healthy bone development. For parents of fussy eaters, consider using oral nutrition supplements for a well-rounded diet. Engage your children in shopping, meal planning, and cooking to increase their interest in eating what they've helped prepare. Make meals more appealing by using cookie cutters to create fun shapes with fruits and vegetables like apples and cucumbers, or serve a colorful variety of foods for breakfast and dinner

3. Exercise: Establish a balanced play regimen for children to limit screen time. On holidays, you can motivate kids to embrace a 'gadget-free' day and encourage them to spend time with the entire family. If your child doesn't eat enough calories and nutrients, nutrition supplements can help fill some of the gaps. Supplements act as both gap-covers as well as catalysts, enhancing the body's capability to absorb essential vitamins and minerals from the foods your child consumes. It's like turning up the volume on nutrient absorption, so their body can make the most of every single bite.

## A Gallbladder Disease Notorious problem in human Prof. Dr. Neelamekam Thoppa Kapali HOD Surgical Gastroenterology, MAS and Multi Organ Transplant Surgeon, Fortis Malar, Adyar

Chennai, Nov 21 2023: One vital organ that is not given the same attention as the heart, kidneys, and other organs is the gallbladder. Most of the time, people only think it when something goes wrong or have indigestion.

The upper right portion of the abdomen contains the gallbladder. The primary job of the gallbladder is a storehouse and the bile produced by the liver and transport it via the common bile duct to the duodenum during meals. The bile aids in the breakdown and digestion of the fat we ingest. The gallbladder discharges bile into the small intestine when a meal contains fatty foods, where it is combined with partially digested food to break down lipids. The bile secreted during the function of the small intestine is retained in the gallbladder as it's a store house of bile.

When does a gallbladder issue show up? The tube that allows bile to go from the liver to the gallbladder and ultimately to the duodenum is called the bile duct. The most frequent cause of blockage is stone formation, which can happen because of changes in phospholipid, cholesterol, and bile concentrations. An infection that ascends from the duodenum or the small intestine into the gall bladder and causes acalculous cholecystitis and Cholangitis can occur.

It may cause discomfort in a patient even in the absence of stones, mainly in critical care patients in ICU.

Signs and symptoms of Gallbladder problem

Abdominal pain is a primary symptom of gallbladder problems. The bile becomes hardened or forms



gallstones, which obstructs the flow and causes discomfort that can range from moderate to severe just below the ribcage. At first, this pain may last anywhere from 30 minutes to several hours, but later, it may worsen and cause constant pain.

Along with the pain in the right side of the abdomen, the patient may also have the following symptoms. These are:

- Reduced appetite
- Fatigue
- Loss of weight
- Dark urine, yellowing of the eyes and skin (jaundice)
- Variations in temperature
- Itching
- Sweating at night
- Light-coloured or pale stools
- Right upper abdominal pain frequently

There is a chance that a rare condition like gallbladder cancer will cause the bile ducts to shrink or become obstructed. Most cases of this cancer are discovered when it is in its latter stages and typically exhibits no symptoms. It can be because the symptoms are difficult to distinguish from other gallbladder issues due to their overlap. The Polyps are a type of noncancerous development that can occur and can become malignant. Polyps might not produce obvious or palpable

laparoscopic removal of gall bladder as treatment. If the stones are in the gallbladder, surgery may be required. If surgery is not an option in asymptomatic gall stones medication will be suggested to reverse the effects of the stones; certain medications, such as UDCA may be tried as treatment which may take months to resolve if it works, and it is only effective for small stones that are less than 5mm.

The treatment is to remove the gallbladder. The gold standard is laparoscopic removal of gall bladder. Here the gall bladder has to be removed as the stones are formed because of the dysfunction of the gall bladder. Laparoscopy is the gold standard surgery and open technique has become obsolete.

Preventing gallbladder problem:

Prevention is better than cure, as the saying goes. The following actions could be useful in avoiding gallbladder issues.

- Eating a balanced diet every day
- Limiting onto junk food and processed meat
- Keeping your BMI in check
- Exercise regularly
- Moderately drink or avoid alcohol
- Maintain appropriate levels of cholesterol and sugar

If left untreated, a gallbladder issue could persist and cause pain indefinitely and cause digestive symptoms. While some issues only result in mild discomfort, others can possibly pose a threat for life with septic complications. Early diagnosis and treatment are crucial because many gallbladder issues can be treated immediately, and the results are good with proper surgical intervention.
