

Modi assumes office, signs first file related to farmers welfare

Chennai, June 10 2024: After being sworn in as Prime Minister for the 3rd time, PM Modi Narendra Modi's signed his first file authorising the release of 17th installment of PM Kisan Nidhi. The scheme will benefits 9.3 crore farmers and distribute around Rs 20,000 crores.

After signing the file, PM Modi said "Ours is a Government fully committed to Kisan Kalyan. It is therefore fitting that the first file signed on taking charge is related to farmer welfare. We want to keep working even more for the farmers and the agriculture sector in the times to come."

The first meeting of the new cabinet is expected to be held this evening at the Prime Minister's residence at Lok Kalyan Marg. The allocation of ministerial portfolios is anticipated shortly thereafter.

Narendra Modi was sworn in as the Prime Minister of India for his third consecutive term on Sunday at the Rashtrapati Bhavan in an impressive ceremony attended by



leaders from India's neighbourhood and the Indian Ocean region. President Droupadi

Murmu administered the oath of office to PM Modi, who was seen wearing a full-sleeved white kurta with churidar and a blue half jacket, followed by other members of his team of ministers.

PM Modi's previous two terms have been characterized by key initiatives such as Ayushman Bharat, Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana, Housing for All, Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Man Dhan Yojana, Ujjwala Yojana, PM Kisan Samman Nidhi, UDAN, and Make in India. He has also focused on creating next-generation infrastructure, expediting pending projects, and promoting environmental conservation. PM Modi led the BJP-led NDA to a third successive victory in the Lok Sabha polls, with the BJP winning an absolute majority on its own in the 2014 and 2019 elections. He has laid thrust on making India a developed nation by 2047 and has expressed confidence in using his experience to navigate the country through global crises and tensions.

Ahead of the oath-taking ceremony, Modi had a pep talk with the minister-designates, saying people have huge expectations and everyone will have to

deliver, sources said. "Be humble as common people love those who are humble and never compromise on probity and transparency," he told the ministers-designate.

The strength of the

Modi's third term, which always appeared inevitable, did not come with the massive mandate he and his party claimed, as the Congress and its allies in the INDIA bloc fought a dooughty rearguard battle to shock the BJP in its strongholds such as Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan. The BJP had to depend on its pre-poll allies to help the NDA get a majority to form the government after a marathon election.

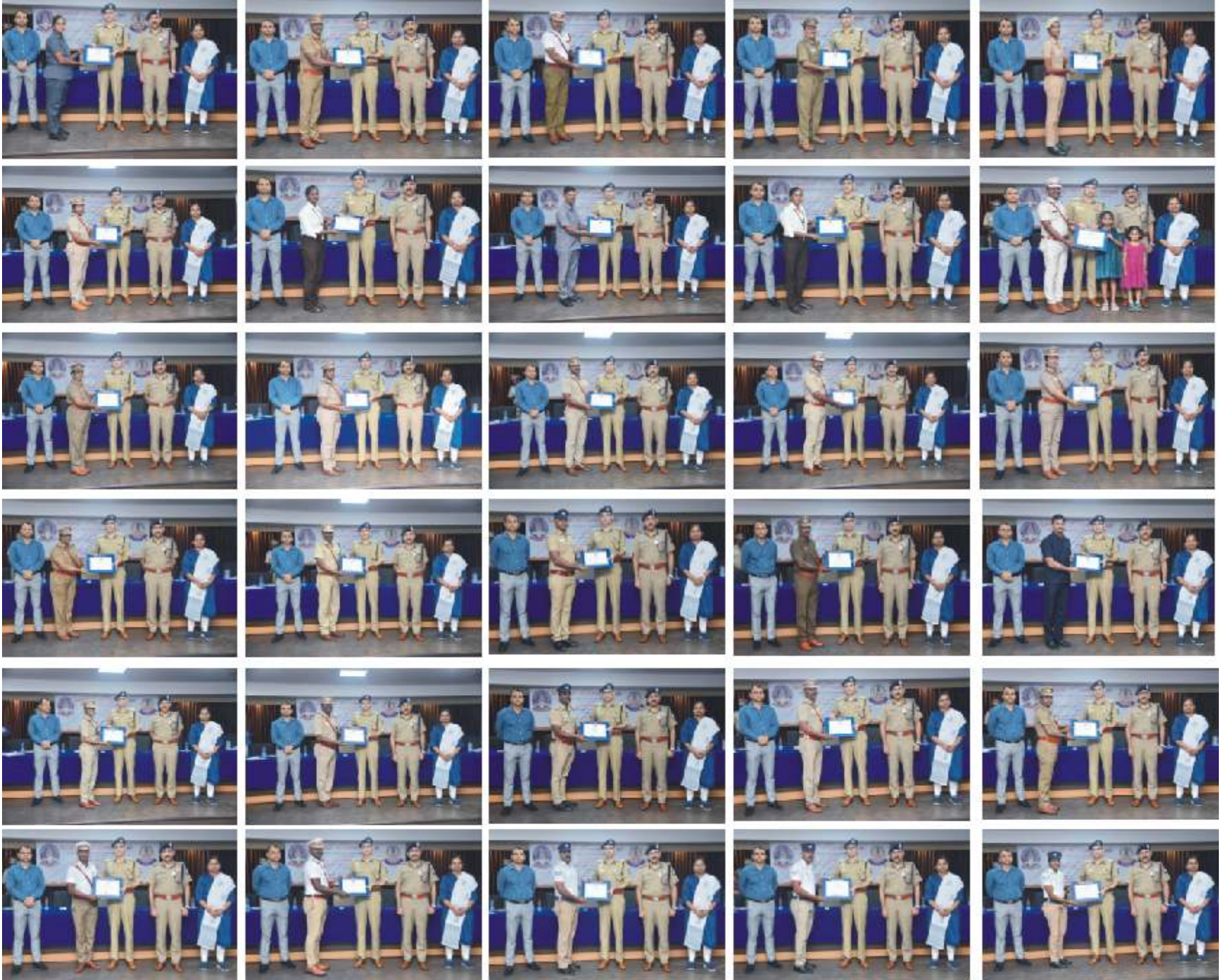

Chennai June 10 2024: The Election Commission schedules Vikravandi bypoll on July 10. The byelection to Vikravandi Assembly constituency, which was necessitated by the death of DMK legislator N Pugazhendi, will be held on July 10, announced

the Election Commission of India on Monday. It is one of the 13 constituencies in seven states that will go to bypolls on that day.

According to the Election Commission notification, last date for

filing nominations is June 21 and the nominations will be scrutinised on June 24.

In terse message, Pak PM felicitates Modi

Chennai June 10 2024: Pakistan Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif on Monday conveyed his felicitations to Prime Minister Narendra Modi on taking oaths as PM.

In a post on X, Sharif posted: "Felicitations to @narendramodi on taking oath as the Prime Minister of India." The single line sentence was akin to what PM Modi had wished the Pakistan PM on his taking over the helm of government in March this year.

Modi had in a terse post, said: "Congratulations to @CMShehbaz on being sworn-in as the Prime Minister of Pakistan." Stating India's position on relations with Pakistan, External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar had said in May this year that Islamabad will have to "wind down its terrorism industry" to be treated like a normal neighbour.

Jaishankar had said that in India the "tolerance for any kind of cross border terrorism is

very low and there will be consequences for it", adding that this was the "message of Uri and Balakote" strikes on terror camps in Pakistan by India.

He said that India has "struggled continuously with the fact that Pakistan has unrelentingly practiced terrorism, cross border terrorism", and after the Modi Government came in 2014 India has given up its earlier attitude of tolerating terrorism.

"Now the ball is in their court. If they wind down the industry (terrorism) which they have built up over many, many decades then people will treat them like a normal neighbour. They make this their core competence, then obviously that will define their image," Jaishankar had said.

"So where Pakistan is concerned I think our messaging has been very clear to them," he said.

Prem Singh Tamang to take oath as Sikkim CM

Chennai June 10 2024: Sikkim Krantikari Morcha (SKM) convenor Prem Singh Tamang is set to take oath as the chief minister of the Himalayan state for the second consecutive term on Monday.



"My priorities are water, electricity, roads, education, health and infrastructure development..." Tamang said speaking to the media, as he came to attend the swearing-in ceremony of PM Modi in Delhi.

Tamang and his Council of Ministers will be administered the oath of office at the Paljor stadium in Gangtok. The swearing-in ceremony will commence at 4 pm and will likely be

attended by around 30,000 people.

The ruling SKM secured a resounding victory in the state, clinching a landslide win by capturing 31 out of 32 seats in the assembly

elections. In contrast, the Sikkim Democratic Front (SDF) only managed to secure a victory in the Shyari constituency.

Tamang emerged victorious in the Rhenock constituency, decisively defeating his SDF rival Som Nath Poudyal by a margin of 7,044 votes. Furthermore, SDF supremo Pawan Chamling, who had led his party to five terms in power from 1994 to 2019, suffered defeat in both seats he had contested from.

Reasi terror attack: NIA team reaches JK, to coordinate with local police

Chennai June 10 2024: An NIA team has reached Jammu and Kashmir's Reasi district and is coordinating with local police probing into the terror attack on a passenger bus that left nine people dead and several injured, officials said on Monday.

Meanwhile, security forces have

also launched a massive cordon and search operation to track down the terrorists responsible for the attack.

A National Investigation Agency (NIA) team has reached Reasi and is coordinating with the local police probing into the attack, the officials said.

Terrorists opened fire at the 53-seater bus, on its way from the Shiv Khori temple to the Mata Vaishno Devi shrine in Katra, causing it to veer off the road and fall into a deep gorge near the Teryath village of the Poni area on Sunday.

The bus was ferrying pilgrims from Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan and Delhi.

Officials said nine people, including a two-year-old boy from Rajasthan and a 14-year-old from Uttar Pradesh, died in the attack.

They added that 41 people aged between three and 50 were injured in the ambush. Of them, 10 suffered gunshot injuries.
