

DMK holds protest against Centre for neglecting TN in Union Budget

Chennai July 27 2024: Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (DMK) on Saturday held protests across Tamil Nadu against the Centre, alleging that the state was neglected in the Union Budget 2024.

The protest comes ahead of the 9th NITI Aayog 's Governing Council meeting chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi at the Rashtrapati Bhavan Cultural Centre in the national capital.

Earlier, Tamil Nadu Chief Minister MK Stalin attacked the Bharatiya Janata Party government over the Union Budget and said that the budget seems like a "vengeful act"

against the States and people who boycotted the BJP.

"Vanakkam! I was supposed to attend the 'NITI Aayog meeting currently being held in Delhi, chaired by the Prime Minister. However, I am compelled to speak before you, in the people's forum, seeking justice due to the discriminatory attitude towards Tamil Nadu reflected in Union Budget 2024," Stalin said.

Chennai, July 27 2024: In a consultative meeting, Anna DMK General Secretary Edappadi Palaniswami advised office bearers that they must show their full strength in the 2026 Assembly elections.

Edappadi Palaniswami has been conducting consultations with district administrators regarding the defeat in the parliamentary elections. Initially, from the 10th to the 19th, he consulted with administrators from 26 constituencies. Following this, the second round of consultations began on the 24th. Consultations were held with administrators from the Theni, Arani, Tenkasi, and Erode constituencies.

Yesterday morning, Edappadi Palaniswami held consultations with Tiruppur constituency administrators, and in the evening with Cuddalore parliamentary constituency administrators, at the Anna DMK headquarters in Royapettah, Chennai.

Will Kamala Harris bloom as US President?

Chennai, July 27 2024: At his first rally following the attempted assassination last week, Donald Trump who dodged the bullet, cleverly attempted to take advantage of the situation in the manner of a conventional politician. Declaring that he had taken "a bullet for democracy" he urged his followers to keep fighting until November when he would reach the White House.

He also claimed that if he had been the President, Putin would not have invaded Ukraine, in keeping with his trademark political hypocrisy. He also mentioned how well he gets along with Chinese president Xi Jinping. Trump has consistently blended conspiracy theories, rage, lies and sweeping plans into his theatrical speeches.

However, following the bullet hit and Biden's retreat, he regained his confidence and was unfazed by Kamala. It was a smart and belated sensible move for Biden to withdraw from the presidential contest and accept the reality that Kamala Harris alone can defeat Trump. The vision seems to be paying dividend with spurt in support for Kamala and the lavish donations that are pouring in.

US Vice President Kamala Harris, who is also among the favorites to receive the presidential nomination from the Democratic Party, has all reasons to

celebrate. Ever since President Joe Biden decided to end his election campaign, she has raised in a jiffy, a total of \$231 million through political donations. This high-dollar fund-raising world is whirring to life for Kamala after weeks, in which Democratic donors were dejected, demoralized and utterly battered. They all are now on a momentum to back Harris and wish that she beat Trump hollow. The donors profile includes small donors as well as big donations.

With the US presidential elections having come closer, Vice President Kamala Harris has opened up a marginal two-percentage-point lead over Republican Donald Trump after President Joe Biden ended his re-election campaign and passed the torch to her, according to a Reuters/Ipsos poll.

Harris, whose campaign says she has secured the Democratic nomination, led Trump 44% to 42% in the national poll, a difference within the 3-percentage-point margin of error.

Harris and Trump were tied at 44% in a July 15-16 poll, and Trump led by one percentage point in a July 1-2 poll, both within the same margin of error. While nationwide surveys give important signals of American support for political candidates, just a handful of competitive

states typically tilt the balance in the US Electoral College, which ultimately decides who wins a presidential election.

Some 56% of registered voters agreed with a statement that Harris, 59, was "mentally sharp and able to deal with challenges," compared to 49% who said the same of Trump, 78.

Biden, 81, ended his reelection effort after a debate with Trump in which he often stammered and failed to aggressively challenge attacks by Trump that included falsehoods.

Some 80% of Democratic voters said they viewed Biden favorably, compared to 91% who said the same of Harris. Three-quarters of Democratic voters said they agreed with a statement that the party and voters should get behind Harris now, with only a quarter saying multiple candidates should compete for the party's nomination

When voters in the survey were shown a hypothetical ballot that included independent presidential candidate Robert F. Kennedy Jr., Harris led Trump 42% to 38%, an advantage outside the margin of error. Kennedy, favored by 8% of voters in the poll, has yet to qualify for the ballot in many states ahead of the Nov. 5 election.

Harris campaigned in the critical battleground state of Wisconsin on

Tuesday. She won support from major party figures, and attention has since turned to who she will pick as her running mate.

Many respondents in the Reuters/Ipsos poll said they knew nothing about the Democrats seen as potential picks to join Harris' ticket.

About one in four registered voters said they had never heard of US Transportation Secretary Pete Buttigieg, a former Democratic presidential candidate who had the highest favorability rating (37% of the potential Harris running mates) in the poll.

One in three had not heard of California Governor Gavin Newsom, with about the same share saying they looked on him favorably. Half of the registered voters in the poll had never heard of Arizona Senator Mark Kelly, and two-thirds knew nothing of Kentucky Governor Andy Beshear.

The poll, which was conducted online, surveyed 1,241 US adults nationwide, including 1,018 registered voters.

Michelle Obama, and Harris.

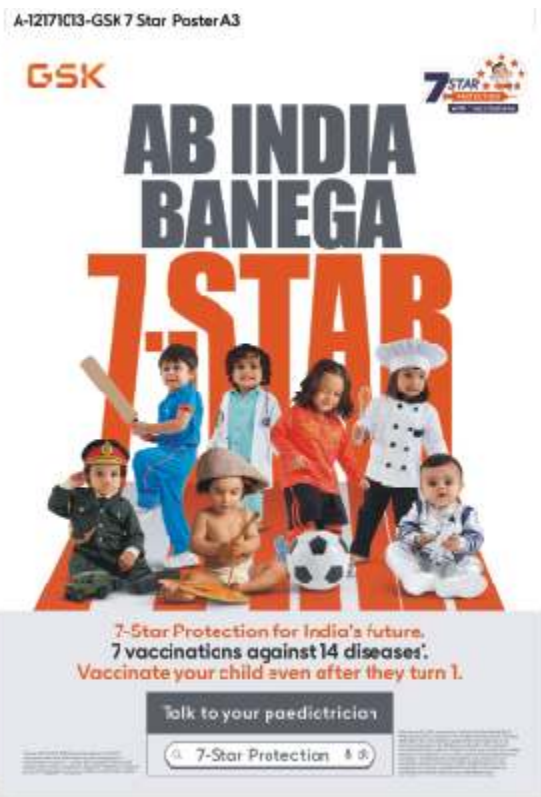
He vowed, "We're going to do everything we can to make sure she wins in November," urging the public to join.

"We learn from our experience, especially during the pandemic, after the pandemic, and also due to the war, this food security issue is still a big challenge for all of us, for the world and also for the region," Foreign Affairs Minister Retno Marsudi said, according to her statement.

Last year, during Indonesia's chairmanship, ASEAN and India agreed on the Joint Leaders' Statement on Strengthening Food Security and Nutrition in Response to Crises.

Marsudi expressed the hope that ASEAN and India will jointly implement cooperation to strengthen food security in response to conflict.

In the maritime sector, the Minister said, maintaining maritime peace and stability is a common goal of ASEAN and India. "We all certainly want this maritime domain to be an arena for cooperation, and not an arena for confrontation," she stressed.

Indonesia has pushed for the concrete implementation of the ASEAN-India Joint Statement on Maritime Cooperation agreed upon last year in Jakarta, especially in the areas of blue economy development, maritime connectivity, and sustainable maritime energy resource development.

In terms of cooperation between ASEAN and countries in the Indian Ocean Rim (IORA), Marsudi submitted a proposal to translate ASEAN-IORA cooperation into an action plan.

She asked India, as an important and respected member of IORA, to support the strengthening of cooperation between ASEAN and IORA.

With over 400 orthopaedic surgeons from all over the country in attendance, it is evident

Chennai Upper Limb Unit is a dedicated specialist centre in Alwarpet that exclusively caters to patients with problems affecting the shoulder, elbow, wrist and hand. Inaugurated this year by Dr Radhakrishnan IAS, it is the first of its kind in India, offering treatment for all kinds of upper limb trauma, sports injuries and joint replacement. The patient's well-being is at the core of Chennai Upper Limb Unit's philosophy, a trait that is reflected in the clinic's state-of-the-art equipment and physiotherapy services.

Dr Ram Chidambaram, founding director of the Chennai Upper Limb Unit, is a senior consultant shoulder & upper limb surgeon with over 30 years of experience in India and the UK. In 2011, he left behind a flourishing orthopaedic practice in the UK's National Health Service and settled in Chennai. He developed an exclusive practice in sports medicine and treating upper limb ailments and is now regarded as one of the best shoulder



and upper limb surgeons in Asia. He has performed over 4,500 keyhole surgeries, 1,100 joint replacements and 3,500 upper limb trauma surgeries. He served as the president of Shoulder and Elbow Society, India for 4 consecutive years, from 2017 to 2021.

Dr Ram has a passion for reverse shoulder arthroplasty, a unique and novel procedure where the ball is replaced with a prosthetic socket and vice versa. He is credited with performing the first reverse shoulder replacement in South India in 2011, and the first stemless shoulder in 2012. Regarding the Arthrex VIP system, Dr Ram says 'Shoulder replacement surgery is a procedure to ease pain and regain function in people with severe shoulder joint issues like arthritis or fracture. Traditional methods sometimes struggle with precise implant placement. This new system is a game-changer designed to tackle these issues, customising the implant according to the patient's unique anatomy.'

HoloLens technology, Dr Ram says 'We use AI to process information from the patient's CT scans to identify the best possible placement for the glenoid peg and screws. I wear the HoloLens during surgery, take references from bone points, and project the 3D hologram on patients in real time during the operation. This helps to further heighten the accuracy and precision of my surgery.'

With robust implant placement, smaller incisions and far less tissue damage, patients operated with this technology can make a much faster recovery. In fact, they don't even need a sling! Patients can start moving their arm the very next day after the operation.

Dr Ram has also made it his mission to improve public perception of upper limb injuries and encourage the right way to seek treatment. The Chennai Upper Limb Unit is proud to launch its newest feature - a 24-hour helpline that allows prospective patients to call in and learn more about their conditions and seek second opinions, in addition to booking appointments and scheduling surgeries. He wishes to provide the best service possible to every patient that seeks his care, and through his teaching initiatives and clinical milestones, he hopes to inspire others to do the same.
