

Flipkart Achieves 10,000 Electric Vehicle Deployment Milestone in Delivery Fleet, Strengthening Its Path To A 100% Electric Logistics Network By 2030 Chennai Nov

Flipkart, 2024: India's homegrown ecommerce marketplace, has achieved a significant milestone, with the deployment of over 10,000 electric vehicles (EVs) in its delivery fleet. This accomplishment is the result of a phased integration of EVs in last mile delivery over the past few years, aligning to its commitment to adopting a fully electric logistics Last-mile fleet by 2030 as part of the Climate Group's EV100 initiative.
