During the inspection, the Vertical Lift Girder Span Bridge along the Broad Gauge Line between Pamban and Mandapam across the Palk Strait, was

Doctor Balaji stable after stabbing incident, OP hit as doctors stay away

Chennai Nov 14 2024: Dr. Balaji, who was stabbed at the Kalaignar Centenary Super Speciality Government Hospital on Wednesday, has recovered from his injuries and is in stable condition, according to hospital director L. Parthasarathy. "Dr. Balaji is now out of danger," Parthasarathy confirmed. "He is stable, had a normal morning meal, is conscious, responding well to family members, and obeying commands. Last night, the Chief Minister spoke with him, and Dr. Balaji was confident in his recovery."

Parthasarathy also outlined increased security measures in response to the incident, including the establishment of police outposts and the deployment of 60 officers across the hospital. "We're doing our best to safeguard all patients and visitors," he said, noting his respect for doctors' decisions on continuing their duties.



Health Minister Ma Subramanian visited Dr. Balaji and confirmed the arrest of the accused, Vigneswaran, who was apprehended by hospital security and charged under Section 7. He also appealed to doctors to call off token protests, thanking them for their continued service. "There were no

disruptions to health services, and we appreciate the cooperation from government doctors and nurses," he stated.

Following discussions with medical unions, the health minister reported that they were satisfied with the government's response, allowing

services to remain unaffected.

On Thursday, doctors across Tamil Nadu, including in Cuddalore District and at Kalaignar Hospital, held peaceful protests in solidarity with Dr. Balaji, calling for better security measures. Dr. Balaji, an oncologist, was reportedly "stabbed at least seven times" by the accused while on duty. Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M.K. Stalin has assured Dr. Balaji of full support from the state government in his recovery and reiterated the government's commitment to the safety of healthcare workers.

First of Its Kind Finance Commissions' Conclave Charts Strategic Roadmap for Rural Fiscal Devolution and Development

Chennai Nov 14 2024: In a significant stride towards fortifying rural governance and reshaping India's local governance financial framework, First of its Kind, a day-long Finance Commissions' Conclave on "Devolution to Development" was organized by the Ministry of Panchayati Raj at Vigyan Bhawan today, with over 150 distinguished participants from 22 States to deliberate on strengthening the fiscal framework of Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs).

Dr. Arvind Panagariya, Chairman of the Sixteenth Finance Commission, delivered the keynote address and articulated a comprehensive vision for fiscal devolution, emphasizing the imperative of enhancing Own Source Revenues (OSR) for sustainable rural development. Drawing from extensive consultations across 11 States, he highlighted the convergence of challenges between rural and urban local bodies, particularly in waste management and carbon emissions, advocating for integrated development approaches. Dr. Panagariya stressed that the path to sustainable rural development lies in strengthening Own

Source Revenues (OSR). "When citizens contribute through taxes, they become active stakeholders in local governance," he added, emphasizing how this participation leads to enhanced accountability and more responsive service delivery at the grassroots level.

Shri Vivek Bharadwaj, Secretary, Ministry of Panchayati Raj, underlined the Ministry's strategic initiatives to reinforce the institutional capacity of State Finance Commissions. He detailed the implementation of systemic reforms, including the development of specialized OSR training modules by IIM Ahmedabad and the deployment of the Samarth portal for enhanced data analytics and demand aggregation. The Ministry's commitment to digital transformation is exemplified by its comprehensive plan to computerize 37,000 Gram Panchayats and establish Gram Panchayat Bhawans in 40,000 locations with populations exceeding 3,000. A significant reform involves the mandatory inclusion of OSR details in Gram Panchayat Development Plans (GDPs) on the eGramswaraj portal,

marking a crucial step towards fiscal transparency. The Ministry's dedicated OSR Cell is actively engaged in reviewing and streamlining revenue rules across states, simplifying complex procedures to enhance efficiency in local governance and facilitating more efficient local resource mobilization.

A comprehensive presentation by Joint Secretary, Ministry of Panchayati Raj, Shri Alok Prem Nagar, set the stage by outlining key challenges and strategic initiatives in strengthening local body finances. The first technical session delved deep into Local Body Grants, examining the nuanced balance between Tied and Untied Grants. Participants engaged in detailed discussions on enhancing transparency through online availability of local body accounts and establishing robust audit mechanisms. State Finance Commission (SFC) Chairpersons shared valuable insights on improving grant utilization efficiency and ensuring timely fund flows. The second session focused exclusively on Panchayat Finances, addressing the critical trinity of rural

governance – the three 'F's: Funds, Functions, and Functionaries.

A significant emphasis was placed on strengthening State Finance Commissions, with participating Chairpersons discussing challenges in fiscal devolution and proposing solutions for more effective resource allocation. The discussions highlighted the importance of standardizing SFC operations while maintaining flexibility for region-specific challenges. Special attention was given to the unique challenges faced by peri-urban Panchayats in managing rapid development.

The closing session, featuring address by Dr. Arvind Panagariya, synthesized the day's deliberations into actionable recommendations for strengthening local body finances. The presence of senior officials from various Ministries, including Shri Ajay Seth, Secretary, Department of Economic Affairs, and Shri Ashok K. K. Meena, Secretary, Department of Drinking Water & Sanitation, reinforced the Government's commitment to an integrated approach to rural development.

DRDO successfully completes Flight Tests of Guided Pinaka Weapon System

Chennai Nov 14 2024: Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) has successfully completed the Flight Tests of Guided Pinaka Weapon System as part of Provisional Staff Qualitative Requirements (PSQR) Validation Trials. The flight tests have been conducted in three phases at different field firing ranges.

During these tests, the PSQR parameters viz., ranging, accuracy, consistency and rate of fire for multiple target engagement in a salvo mode have been assessed by extensive testing of rockets. Twelve (12) rockets from each production agency from two in-service Pinaka launchers



upgraded by the launcher production Establishment in association with agencies have been tested.

Secretary, Department of Defence R&D and Chairman DRDO Dr Samir V Kamat also congratulated the teams associated with the trials and said the rocket system has completed all pre-requisite flight trials before induction into the Indian Army.

Toxic smog chokes Delhi as air quality remains severe; over 200 flights delayed

Chennai Nov 14 2024: Delhi woke up to yet another morning of thick smog with the pollution remaining in the 'severe' category for the second consecutive day. The Air Quality Index (AQI) stood at 432 at 6 a.m., a slight improvement from the 'very severe' 452 recorded at 11 pm yesterday. Visibility at Delhi's Indira Gandhi International (IGI) Airport dropped, leading to 203 flights being delayed according to Flightradar.

Congress leader Priyanka Gandhi

Vadra, reflecting on her return to Delhi from Wayanad, said the experience was like "entering a gas chamber."

She described the heavy smog covering Delhi, noting that while Wayanad's air quality index was at 35, Delhi's pollution has become a recurring crisis.

Calling for collective action beyond political divides, Priyanka said, "We really should put our heads together and find a solution for cleaner air. It's beyond this party or that, it's practically impossible

to breathe, especially for kids, elderly people and those with respiratory issues. We just have to do something about it."

Flights delayed
According to the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), several areas in the capital region recorded an AQI of over 450. Anand Vihar, Ashok Vihar, Bawana, Dwarka, Jahangirpuri, Mundka, Najafgarh, Lajpat Nagar, Patparganj, Punjabi Bagh, RK Puram, Rohini, Vivek Vihar, and Wazirpur are among several areas in

Delhi where the average AQI was recorded in the 'severe' category, exceeding 450, at 6 am.

Anand Vihar recorded the highest AQI at 473, followed closely by Patparganj at 472, Ashok Vihar at 471, and Jahangirpuri at 470.

Earlier this morning, IndiGo issued a travel advisory on its official X handle, asking passengers to monitor their flight status. The airline warned that some flights may experience delays due to "winter fog."

ICC seeks BCCI views on India's refusal to visit Pak

Chennai Nov 14 2024: The International Cricket Council (ICC) has reached out to the BCCI for clarification following concerns raised by the Pakistan Cricket Board (PCB) regarding India's refusal to visit Pakistan for the upcoming 2025 Champions Trophy.

The ICC has got active after the PCB sent a formal communication to the global cricket managing body raising questions about India's stance on a hybrid model for the tournament,

ED conducts fresh raid on Santiago Martin in money laundering case

Chennai Nov 14 2024: The Enforcement Directorate (ED) launched new searches on Thursday, targeting Santiago Martin, a Chennai-based businessman and the largest donor to political parties, with contributions exceeding Rs 1,300 crore through electoral bonds. This action is part of a continued investigation into alleged money

laundering. The ED's move follows a recent Madras High Court ruling that permitted the agency to proceed with its case against Martin, despite an earlier lower court decision to close the case as per Tamil Nadu Police recommendations.

Authorities carried out searches at multiple locations linked to Martin in Chennai and other areas. Martin, widely known as the

"lottery king," has been under ED investigation since 2019. Last year, the agency seized assets worth Rs 457 crore tied to an alleged fraud involving the sale of Sikkim state lotteries in Kerala, which reportedly resulted in losses of over Rs 900 crore for the Kerala government. Martin's company, Future Gaming Solutions India Pvt. Ltd., has drawn significant attention as the largest purchaser of

electoral bonds, spending more than Rs 1,300 crore between 2019 and 2024. The ED's scrutiny of Martin's finances intensified after the seizure of Rs 7.2 crore in unaccounted cash from his Chennai residence. The recent High Court decision reinforces the ED's mandate to continue its investigation into Martin's financial dealings and activities.

Gold falls by Rs. 880 per sovereign

Chennai Nov 14 2024: The price of 22-carat gold in Chennai continued its recent decline, dropping by Rs 110 per gram on November 14, bringing the current rate to Rs 6,935 per gram. This marks a fall of Rs 880 per sovereign, with the new price now at Rs

55,480 per sovereign. Over the past two weeks, the price of gold has decreased by Rs 3,840 per sovereign, a stark contrast to October's all-time highs when it reached Rs 59,520 on October 30. At that point, gold seemed on track to reach Rs 60,000 per sovereign,

but has since taken a downward turn.

lowering the likelihood of major rate cuts by the US Federal Reserve, while easing tensions in the Middle East factors contributing to the correction in gold prices. Meanwhile, silver prices have also slipped slightly, with the rate for one gram now at Rs 99, down by Rs 2.
